## Block Layout



NOTE - T-Templates and Units Block Layout: In the Block Layout above, the T-Templates are shown from the Front Side of the Quilt and the Units are shown from the backside (or the side of the paper with the lines and writing on it). Lay the T-Templates and Units out on a design wall (You won't have enough of $T$-Template B2 to complete 1 full side layout, but just put them up and recognize they are repeated in all of the open spaces. When you have one side laid out, label the foundation papers with the Block unit and Bag Unit. Paper clip (3) other Unit B2 with Block A: a, (clip (3) other Unit B2 with Block B:b, clip (3) other Unit B1 with Block B:c, and (3) other Unit B1 with Block B:d. Label the T-Templates B1 to B3 as shown above and place into Bag \#5. You will have (4) T-Template B2 labeled for Fabric B6 and (2) T-Template B2 labeled for Fabric B5.

## - Pasting Swatches on Papers

Now that the papers are laid out on the table or pinned to your design wall (and labeled with the Block name and the Bag \# from the Block Layout above), you can begin pasting fabric swatches into the papers as shown below. You do not have to do every paper, but do the top one in each clipped stack and keep all the clipped papers together. Paste the fabrics in the reference blocks below, first. Then, paste them on the foundation papers in the same location! Finally, place the Units back into the appropriate bag.

- Block B:a, Unit B2, Bag \#4, Make 4

- Block Bib, Unit B2, Bag \#4, Make 4
