

- Bag #A7: (1) of each T-Templates A-5 and A-6


Preparing the Foundation Papers:


Step 1: Cut out (2) of each SS Foundation Sheet [NP 485], (8) of each Unit A1, A2, A3, A4, and A5 [NP 486], and (1) of each Template, T-Template, SS Template, and Template Layout Sheet on [TP 299 and TP 300]. See the newsprint graphics to the right for information on how to organize your units and templates into bags. **Refer back to General Information Booklet for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.*

NOTE - Interior Foundation Paper Cut Lines on the Foundation Sheets: Each foundation sheet includes **(4)** rows of diamonds. The rows are not cut apart until after the paper piecing is completed.









