NOTE - Unit SSR \& SSL Background TLS: In the first printing of this TLS, we realized that we did not add the Sew Sides correctly to all of the Templates. In the stacking instructions, you will nee a note to simply ignore the Sew Sides and position the Template stack as demonstrated in the graphics. We will correct the labels in later printings.

## UNIT SSL AND SSR CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAGS \#B1 \& B2

## Fabric B1

Step 1: From Fabric B1, cut (3) $7^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Stack the strips right-side-up into (1) stack.


Step 2: The Unit SSR \& SSL Background TLS is used to sub-cut (8) rectangles the size of the Template Layout Sheet from the (3) strips. You will have (1) rectangle left over.


Step 3: Re-stack the fabric pieces into (1) stack of (8). Then, place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together and place half of the Templates into Bag \#B1 and half the Templates into Bag \#B2.


## Fabric B2

Step 1: From Fabric B2, cut (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Stack the strips right-side-up on your cutting table.


Step 2: The Unit SSR Accent TLS is used to sub-cut (4) parallelograms the size of the TLS from each strip.


Step 3: Place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together and place the pieces into the Bag \#B2.


## Fabric B3

Step 1: From Fabric B3, cut (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Stack the strips right-side-up on your cutting table.


Step 2: The Unit SSL Accent TLS is used to sub-cut (4) parallelograms the size of the TLS from each strip.


Step 3: Place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together and place the pieces into the Bag \#B1.


## SORTING AND STACKING UNIT SSL AND SSR: BAGS \#B1 AND \#B2

Sort the pieces in Bag \#B1 on your table with the templates and fabric pieces facing right-side-up. You will have (1) accent piece and (2) background pieces. The stacking begins with the Template for Sec. 3 on the bottom. The sew sides are aligned at the top. The pieces are then stacked in reverse order, finishing with Template for Sec. 1 on top. Sec. 1 does not have a Sew Side.
