## Fabric B1

Step 1: From Fabric B1, cut (4) $7-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Stack the strips right-side-up into (2) stacks of (2) strips.


Step 2: Unit BL Background TLS is used to sub-cut (4) stacks of rectangles the size of the Template Layout Sheet from one set of (2) strips.


Step 3: Unit BR Background TLS is used to sub-cut (4) stacks of rectangles the size of the Template Layout Sheet from one set of (2) strips.


Step 4: Re-stack the fabric pieces into two stacks of (8), with (1) stack being for the Unit BL TLS and the other being for Unit BR. Then, place the respective TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together and place the Unit BL Templates into Bag \#B1 and the Unit BR Templates into Bag \#B2.


## Fabric B2

Step 1: From Fabric B2, cut (2) $10^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Stack the strips right-side-up on your cutting table.


Step 2: The Unit BL \& BR Accent Spikes TLS is used to sub-cut (4) rectangles the size of the TLS from each strip.


Step 3: Re-stack the fabric pieces into a stack of (8) pieces. Then, place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together and place the Unit BL Templates into Bag \#B1 and the Unit BR Templates into Bag \#B2.
