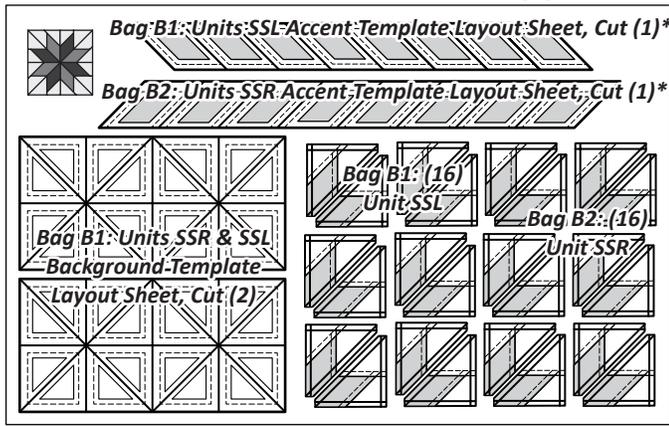


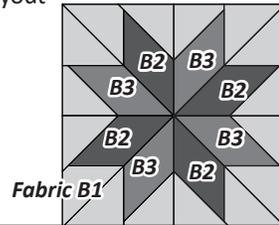
► (1) TP 95



NOTE - Unit SSR & SSL Accent TLS: There is only (1) set of Unit SSL and SSR Accent TLSs included in this pattern. For the second Table Runner, you will either need to cut the ones you have in half and only use half of it, reserving the remaining for the second runner or, you can simply save a few templates with the second runner, lay them on a strip of fabric and cut the diamonds to size using just one template at a time. There are enough background TLS to use (1) for each Table Runner.

► **Small Star Fabric Information:**

The table below includes yardage, fabric references, and which fabrics should go with which cutting templates to complete Group B. This table is your guide for keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the Assigned Colors column! Reference the Color Layout below for where each fabric goes.



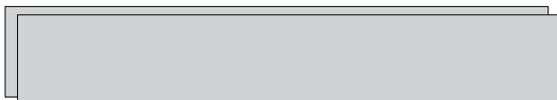
► **Group B: Color Layout (Front-side)**

Fabric B2 Unit SSR Accent TLS	1/4 yd or 5"	FABRIC SWATCH
Fabric B3 Unit SSL Accent TLS	1/4 yd or 5"	FABRIC SWATCH

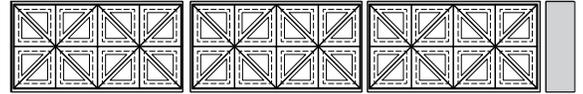
■ **UNIT SSL AND SSR CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAGS #B1 & B2**

► **Fabric B1**

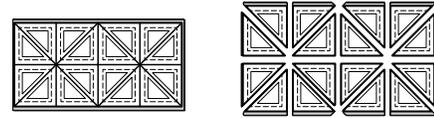
Step 1: From Fabric B1, cut (2) 7" x 42" strips. Stack the strips *right-side-up* into (1) stack.



Step 2: The *Unit SSR & SSL Background TLS* is used to sub-cut (4) rectangles the size of the Template Layout Sheet from the (2) strips. You will have (2) rectangles left over. Place leftovers with scraps.

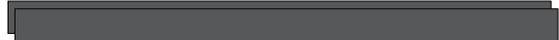


Step 3: Re-stack the fabric pieces into (1) stack of (4). Then, place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together and place the LSL Templates into Bag #B1 and the LSR Templates into Bag #B2.



► **Fabric B2**

Step 1: From Fabric B2, cut (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips. Stack the strips *right-side-up* on your cutting table.



Step 2: The *Unit SSR Accent TLS* is used to sub-cut (2) parallelograms the size of the TLS from each strip.

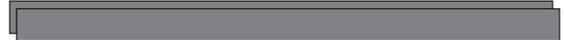


Step 3: Place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Stack the pieces into (1) stack, then clip a template on top and place the pieces into the Bag #B2. Reserve the remaining templates for the second table runner.



► **Fabric B3**

Step 1: From Fabric B3, cut (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips. Stack the strips *right-side-up* on your cutting table.



Step 2: The *Unit SSL Accent TLS* is used to sub-cut (2) parallelograms the size of the TLS from each strip.



Step 3: Place the TLS on top and slice through the cut lines, in numerical order to cut the pieces apart. Stack the pieces into (1) stack, then clip a template on top and **place the pieces into the Bag #B1**. Reserve the remaining templates for the second table runner.



■ **SORTING AND STACKING UNIT SSL AND SSR: BAGS #B1 AND #B2**

Sort the pieces in Bag #B1 on your table with the templates and fabric pieces facing *right-side-up*. You will have (1) accent piece and (2) background pieces. The stacking begins with the Template for Sec. 3 on the bottom. The sew sides are aligned at the top. The pieces are then stacked in reverse order, finishing with Template for Sec. 1 on top. Sec. 1 does not have a Sew Side.
