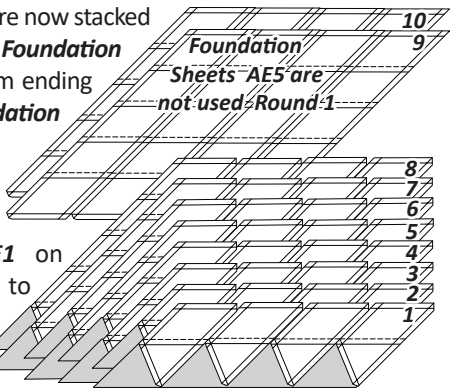


### ► Stacking Order

The Foundation Sheets are now stacked starting with (2) each of **Foundation Sheet AE5** on the bottom ending with (2) each **Foundation Sheet AE1** on the top.

Number your papers 1-10 starting with **Foundation Sheet AE1** on the top. In addition to numbering the papers as shown in the graphic, it also helps



to number the papers on the backside as well under Sec 4. If you don't number the papers, it is very likely that you will get lost in the sewing order.

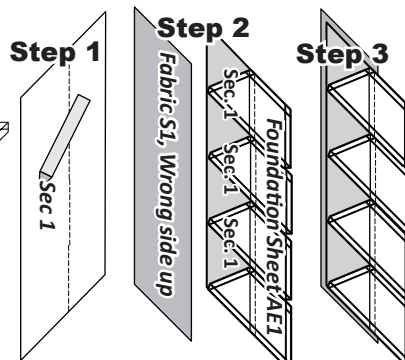
## ■ FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING BAG #AE1: UNIT AE-ROW 1 THROUGH UNIT AE-ROW 5

### ► Round 1:

**Strips 1-8:** The strips in Round 1 are glued onto the backside of each **Foundation Sheet AE1 to AE4**.

- Place Fabric S1, Strip 1, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE1.
- Place Fabric S1, Strip 2, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE1.
- Place Fabric S2, Strip 3, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE2.
- Place Fabric S2, Strip 4, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE2.
- Place Fabric S3, Strip 5, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE3.
- Place Fabric S3, Strip 6, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE3.
- Place Fabric S4, Strip 7, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE4.
- Place Fabric S4, Strip 8, under Sec 1, Foundation Sheet AE4.

**NOTE - Tracing:** You will find it easier to position the strips under the foundation papers if you trace the dashed lines onto the back of your Foundation Sheets to divide the sections.



**Step 1:** Place a small amount of fabric glue on the backside of the paper under the first row of diamonds assigned to Sec. 1.

**Step 2:** Place Strip #1 [Fabric S1] **wrong-side-up** on your table along the edge of **Foundation Sheet AE1** as shown.

**Step 5:** The (6) groups are now stacked together into one stack starting with Round 6 on the bottom finishing with Round 1 on the top. The strip piecing process is designed to add each piece of fabric to the foundation papers in the sequence in which the fabrics are stacked. The process is very simple if you follow the sewing order provided for each Round 1-6 on the following pages.



### ► Preparing your Foundation Papers:

**Step 1:** You have (2) each of the following **Foundation Sheets S1 to S5**. Position them **printed-side-up** on your table as shown below (and at the top of the next column).

**Step 2:** Fabric swatches from each color are cut and pasted onto one of each Foundation Sheet S1- S5.
