



## ► Fabric D1: T-Template D1

Step 1: Cut and stack (2) 12-1/2" by 42" strips facing right-side up. T-Template D1 is used to cut (8) pieces. The T-Template is repositioned with each cut.




**Step 2:** Paper clips are used to keep the template and fabric pieces together. Place these pieces into Bag #D2.



## ► Fabric D2: T-Template D2

Step 1: Cut and stack (4) 2-1/4" by 42" strips facing right-side up. T-Template D2 is used to cut (8) pieces.



Step 2: Paper clips are used to keep the template and fabric piece together. Place these pieces into Bag #D2.


## ► Fabric D3: T-Templates D3, D4, D5, & D6

Step 1: Cut (4) 16" by 42" strips. Subcut (8) 8" by 42" strips facing *right-side up*. Restack the strips into two groups of (4) strips.




**Step 2:** *T-Template D3* is used to cut the first (4) pieces from the first group of strips. Position the D3 template along the left side of

the strips as shown below and cut (4) pieces. *T-Template D4* is used to cut (8) pieces. Reposition the template for each cut.




Step 4: T-Template D6 is used to cut the first (4) pieces from the second group of strips. Position the D6 template along the left side of the strips as shown below and cut (4) pieces. *T-Template* **D5** is used to cut (8) pieces. Reposition the template for each cut.



## ► Fabric D4: Unit D1 thru D6 (TLS) #2

Step 1: Cut (1) 45-1/2" by 42" strip. Subcut and stack (2) 22-3/4" by 42" strips facing right-side up. The Unit D1-D6 Template Layout Sheet #2 is used to cross-cut (12) 6-1/2" by 23" strips.



Step 2: Stack the (12) pieces under (TLS) #2.
