


Step 15: Open the paper, and sew on Line 3. Continue adding the template pieces to each section until the piecing is done.

Transition & Registration Points:

After the paper piecing is completed on each unit, the registration lines are sewn on the foundation papers. The excess fabric and paper is then trimmed off around the perimeter of each unit and the excess threads from the basting stitches are trimmed.

Step 16: Place these pieces back into Bag #D2.


Curved Piecing: If you need help with the curved piecing, reference Page 11 of the Introduction Booklet under **Curved Piecing Tips**.



Foundation Papers: If you have not already done so, remove the foundation papers from the D2 Units. If you need help, reference Page 6 of the Introduction Booklet under **Removing the Foundation Papers**.


Step 17: Position Unit D2 over the top of Unit D1 with **right-sides-together**.

Step 18: Match up and pin the (TRP) lines on Unit D2 with Unit D1.



Step 19: Match and glue the smart corners at both ends of each unit. Then use the glue pen to secure the raw edges along the curve. *TIP: If the pieces are not fitting perfect, use a steam iron to shrink the raw edges until they fit perfect.*

Step 20: Remove the foundation paper from Unit D1, then join the two pieces with a quarter-inch seam allowance. Press the seams towards Unit D1. Set these pieces aside in Bag #D2 until you are ready to assemble the Block Groups.



► **Group D**

NOTE - Yardage: If you plan to make each of your Group D units in different fabrics, you will either have to determine yardage on your own, or use Quiltster, click on the Unlock feature, color your blocks, and get the yardage from the Quiltster project. The table below is for fabric swatches only.
