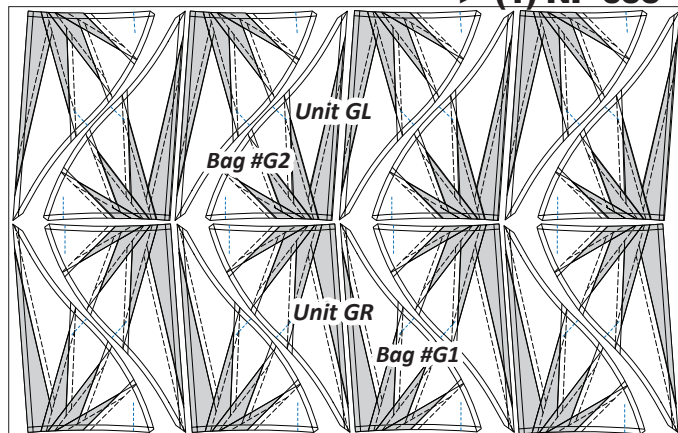
## Booklet Two, Queen Border Group G

**Giant Leaf:** Includes the foundation papers, template layout sheets, and instructions needed to complete:

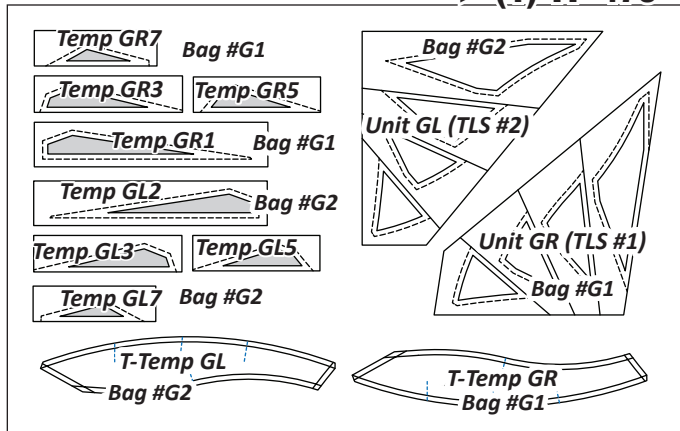
- Units GL & GR: Giant Leaf

**Newsprint NP 655 & TP 470:** The following newsprint includes the Foundation Papers, T-Templates, and Template Layout Sheets required to complete the piecing for Group G.

The Foundation Papers, Templates and Template Layout Sheets are cut out at this time. Reference Page 3 of the Introduction Booklet under **Foundation Papers and Templates** for instructions on how to cut out the Foundation Papers, Templates, and Template Layout Sheets.

After the paper units and templates are cut out, the foundation papers are sorted and grouped together by **Unit Name** then placed into their associated bags listed below. The T-Templates and Template Layout Sheets are clipped together and placed in a separate bag at this time. The sorting of all the templates in each group is completed after the templates are placed with their assigned fabrics and the template cutting is completed for each fabric.

**Ziploc Bags: (2)** large Ziploc bags are needed to keep your fabrics, templates, and papers organized. Label as follows:

- Bag #G1: (8)** each Unit GR Foundation Papers and associated T-Templates & Template Layout Sheets.
- Bag #G2: (8)** each Unit GL, Foundation Papers and associated T-Templates & Template Layout Sheets.

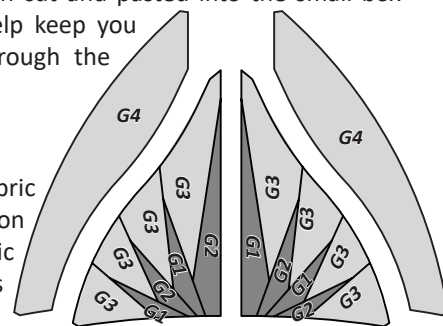
**General Color Information:** At this time you should take a few minutes and study the different quilt samples shown on the cover sheets. *Note: Out of the (14) different samples shown on the cover pages, none of them were designed using the Unlock Button in Quiltster. This means no one chose to make the Giant Leaf units in different fabrics from unit to unit. You can see what this will look like using Quiltster and the Unlock Button. The program gives you adjusted yardage so you can achieve this look if desired. In these instructions, only yardage is provided based on making all the blocks the same color, which is what all the Certified Instructors and Shop Owners chose for their own quilts. If you get more creative, you will need to study the yardage and use Quiltster to understand how to adjust the instructions.*

**Assigned Fabric #:** We have assigned Fabric #s to each of the Sec. #s on the Foundation Units. These Fabric #s pair up with the Fabric #s in Quiltster and the Fabric Charts provided in the Introduction Booklet. These Fabric #s will also be used to reference the Templates and Template Layout Sheets used to cut the fabric pieces throughout these instructions.

**Unit Chart:** There are (4) Fabric #s referenced in the Unit Chart below. A small fabric swatch cut and pasted into the small box on the chart below will help keep you organized as you work through the cutting instructions.

### ► Fabric Layout:

**Fabric-Side-Up:** The fabric layout matches the position of the right-side of the fabric after the units and templates have been cut and sewn.
