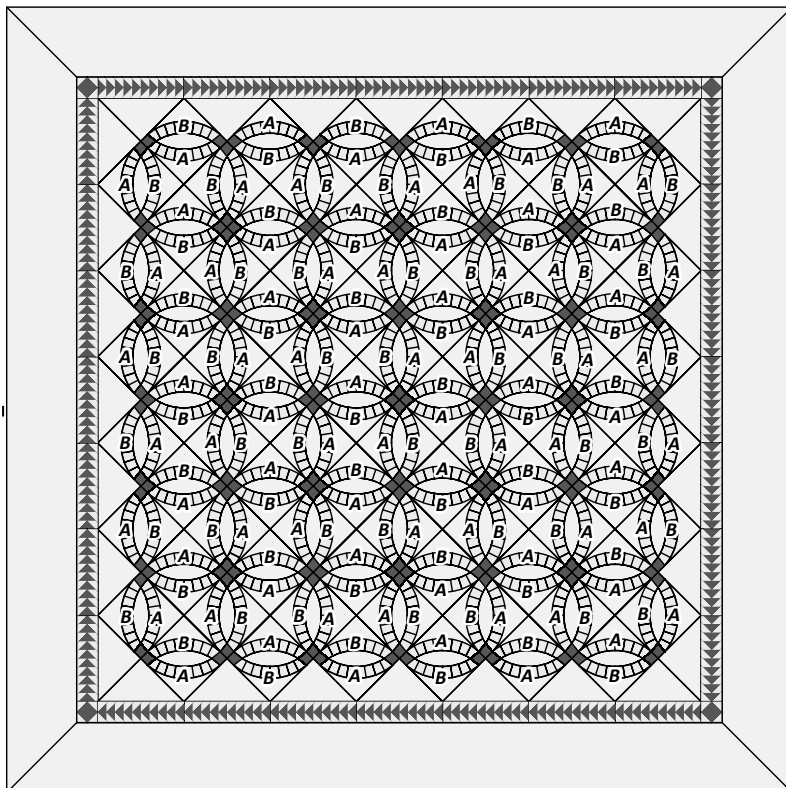


## ► 6 Ring by 6 Ring Layout, 112" by 112"

- (84) Each A and B Units
- (28) G-Units, (4) CS-Units
- (88) 2-1/2" Strips = (11) Ring-Color-Sets
- (84) Melon Template Pieces, (168) Center Template Pieces
- (28) Large Quarter Square Triangles
- (42) each of (2) light and (2) dark fabrics, for the 4-Patches
- (288) 3" Square for the Geese Backgrounds, (280) Geese
- (1) Packages of Extra Foundation Papers

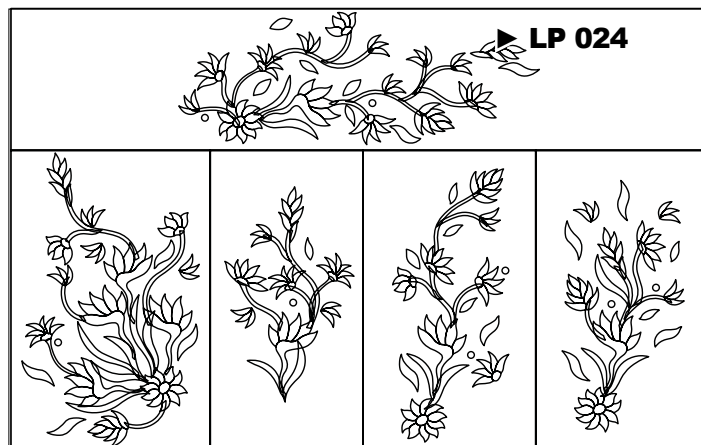


## CHAPTER 4: GROUP 4, APPLIQUE

**Appliqué:** This chapter is all about appliqué. The Laser cut appliqué pieces provided in this booklet are cut from a stabilizer called Stitch-N-Peel. *\*Product Notation Below.* The laser cut template pieces were designed for turn under appliqué. **Store your applique supplies in Bag #5.**

**NOTE - Product Not Fusible:** This product is not a fusible product.

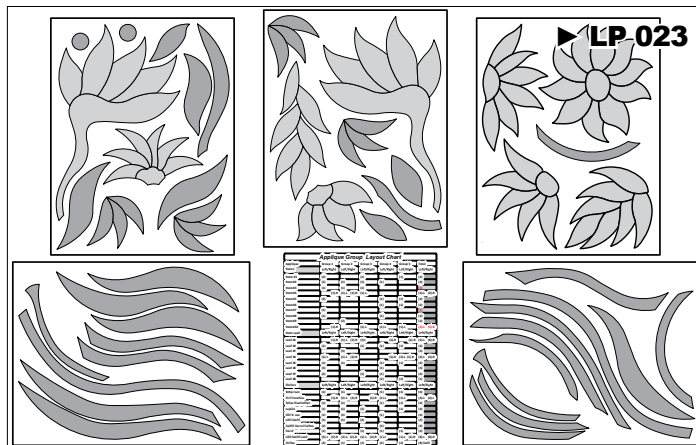
**Applique Layout:** With the Flowers for my Wedding Ring pattern you received (1) package of laser cut Applique pieces. Each package includes enough applique pieces to complete one of each Group Layout 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 as shown on LP 024. An inventory list of the pieces used in each Group Layout is included on LP 023. Foundation Sheet LP 025 includes two layouts with applique. The first layout was created using only one package of the pre-cut applique which is included with your pattern. The second layout uses (2) packages of applique, which is what was used on the Cover Quilt. Additional packages can be purchased at [Quiltworx.com](http://Quiltworx.com) or from a local shop if you choose to duplicate the quilt shown on the cover.



**Applique Cutout Sheets:** The applique templates are provided to you on an Applique Cutout Sheet. You will need to complete the cutting of each individual flower, but please wait until you are ready to start your applique. Step by Step Instructions are provided on the following page.

**Product Notation:** Stitch-N-Peel is a light weight cellulose-based stabilizer used for machine appliqué. It is not a fusible product, but meant for turn under applique. The stabilizer remains in the quilt after the appliqué is completed. Over time the stabilizer will break down and soften as you use the quilt. If and when the quilt is washed, the stabilizer will soften and dissolve into little fibers that will become part of your quilt. The applique templates are cut with a paper backing that is peeled off just before placing it onto your fabric. After the paper backing is removed the pieces are placed sticky side down, on the wrong side of your fabric. If you make a mistake when placing the pieces onto your fabrics, simply peel it off, and reposition.

**LP 023 Appliqué Template Sheet:** Do not cutout the templates pieces on this page. These Template Sheets are used as guides for assembling your flowers.



## TURN UNDER APPLIQUE: SUPPLIES

- Laser Cut Pre-cut Template Package
- Fabric Glue Pen or UHU Glue Stic
- Schmetz Sewing Needles,(60/8) (Sharps Microtex)
- 'Roxanne 'Glue-Baste-It
- Purple Thang
- Size 60, 80, or 100 Weight Appliqué Thread
- We used a collection of like colored 50 wt Aurifil Thread and it worked great!
- Small Embroidery Scissors
- Applique Pressing Sheet
