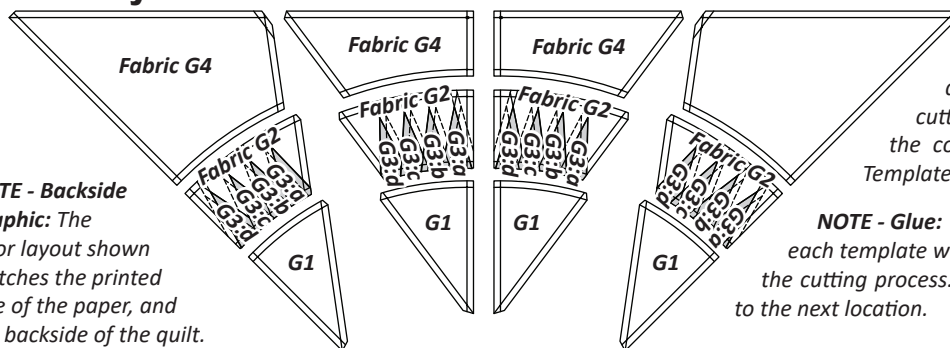


► Color Layout

NOTE - Backside

Graphic: The color layout shown matches the printed side of the paper, and the backside of the quilt.



NOTE - Stacking strips: *Templates and (TLS) are repositioned on the cut strips to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each Template before cutting.

NOTE - Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the templates and (TLS) from moving in the cutting process. After each cut simply reposition the template to the next location.

► Fabric G1, (T-TLS) #1

Step 1: Cut (1) 5-1/2" by 42" strip from *Fabric G1* and place it facing **right-side-up**. Use (T-TLS) #1 to cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the (T-TLS), repositioning it as necessary.



Step 2: Stack the (4) pieces beneath the (T-TLS). Repositionable glue will keep the templates from moving in the cutting process. Cut (8) pieces for each individual template. Place in Bag #G3.

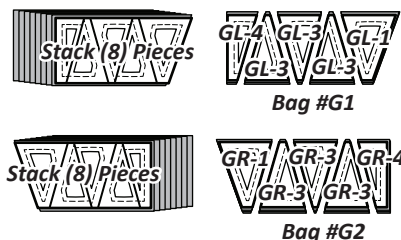


► Fabric G2, (TLS) #2 & 3

Step 1: Cut (4) 4" by 42" strips from *Fabric G2* and stack facing **right-side-up**. Position **Unit GL (TLS) #2** and **Unit GR (TLS) #3** on the stacked strips. Cut (8) pieces the size and shape of each (TLS), repositioning the (TLS) as necessary.



Step 2: Stack the (8) fabric pieces beneath each (TLS). Clip the paper templates to the fabric beneath. The cutting is completed by cutting on each Cut Line to separate the template pieces. Place the left templates in Bag #G1, and the right templates in Bag #G2.

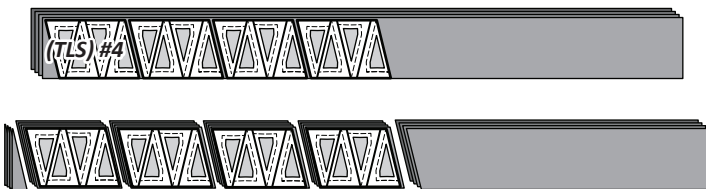


► Fabric G3:a-G3:d, (TLS) #4

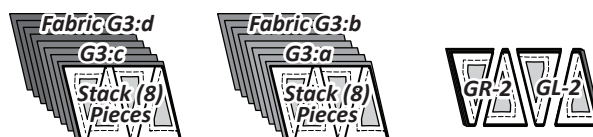
Step 1: Cut (1) 4" by 42" strip each from *Fabrics G3:a, G3:b, G3:c, and G3:d*. Stack the strips facing **right-side-up**, starting with *Fabric G3:d* on the bottom and ending with *G3:a* on top.



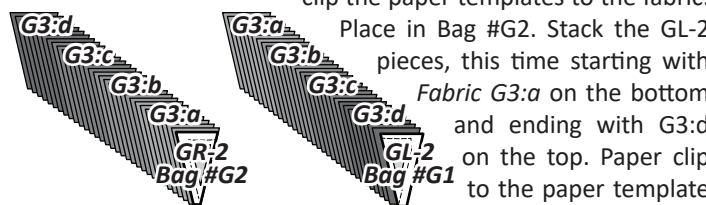
Step 2: The **Units GL & GR (TLS) #4** is used to cut (4) pieces from each fabric, matching the size and shape of the (TLS) and repositioning as necessary.



Step 3: Stack (8) pieces beneath each (TLS). Clip the paper templates to the fabric beneath. The cutting is completed by cutting on each Cut Line to separate the template pieces.



Step 4: Stack the GR-2 fabric pieces, starting with *Fabric G3:d* on the bottom and ending with *G3:a* on top. Paper clips are used to clip the paper templates to the fabric. Place in Bag #G2. Stack the GL-2 pieces, this time starting with *Fabric G3:a* on the bottom and ending with *G3:d* on the top. Paper clip to the paper template and place in Bag #G1.



► Fabric G4, (T-TLS) #5

Step 1: Cut and stack (2) 9" by 42" strips from *Fabric G4* facing **right-side-up**. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of (T-TLS) #5.
