## Color Layout

The color layout shown matches the printed side of the paper, which reflects the backside of the quilt.

## - Fabric B1: Unit B1 \& B2 Background (TLS)

NOTE - If you used the By Block Cutting Instructions in Quiltster under the yardage information to precut your strips, each 13" strip is subcut into (2) 6-1/2" strips in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (16) 6-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric B1. Stack the strips facing right-side up into two groups of (8) strips. Unit B1 Background (TLS) \#1 is aligned with the right edge of your strip on your first stack.


Step 2: Cut (8) pieces matching the size of the (TLS). The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each Cut Line to separate the individual sections. Clip the paper templates to the fabric beneath and place the section templates in Bag \#B1.


Step 3: Unit B2 Background (TLS) \#3 is aligned with the left edge of your second stack and Unit B2 Background (TLS) \#2 is aligned with the right edge. Cut (8) pieces matching the size of each (TLS).


Step 4: Complete the cutting on each Cut Line, clip the paper templates to the fabric beneath and place the section templates in Bag \#B2.

## - Fabric B2:a - B2:m (13 Colors)

Step 1: Cut (1) $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strip from each Fabric B2:a-B2:m. The strips are arranged then stacked in alphabetical order facing right-side-up according to the assigned Fabric \#s.


Step 2: Cut the strips into two equal halves measuring $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ by $21^{\prime \prime}$.


Step 3: After the strips are cut, remove the bottom three, Fabrics $a, b, \& c$, from the first stack, then assign the remaining strips to Unit B1. The second stack is assigned to Unit B2.


Step 4: Position one each Unit B1 \& B2 (TLS) \#4 on each stack.


Step 5: The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each Cut Line to separate the individual sections.


Step 6: The template pieces for Units B1 \& B2 are now sorted by color placing (8) pieces cut from color into one stack. Clip the pieces together then repeat for each additional fabric. Place the templates for Unit B1 in Bag \#B1 and the templates for Unit B2 in Bag \#B2. Note that in both cases, Sect 2 is $\mathrm{B} 2: \mathrm{m}$ and you work your way in reverse alphabetic order to B2:d (Unit B1), and B2:a (Unit B2).
