## Fabric Color Layout

NOTE-Backside Graphic: The color layout shown matches the printed side of the paper, which reflects the backside of the quilt.

## - Fabric Information:

The Unit Chart that follows includes Fabric \#s, yardage/inches, and pairs Fabrics \#s to the Templates and (TLS) for Units G1-G4 and T-Temp G1-G4. The Color Layout to the right provides a visual reference of the location of each Fabric \#.


Step 3: Place the G1-1 Templates with Unit G1 and the G2-1 Templates with Unit G2 in Bag \#G1.


## Fabric G3: (TLS) \#1 \& \#2

Step 1: Cut (2) 7" by 42" strip from Fabric G3. Position each strip facing right-side up. Repositionable fabric glue is placed on the backside of each Unit G1, (TLS) \#1 and Unit G2, (TLS) \#2. The backside of each layout sheet is then placed against the right-side of the fabric. (2) ea. (TLS \#1 \& TLS \#2) are positioned onto each strip.


Step 2: Cut around each layout sheet leaving about $3 / 16^{\prime \prime}$ of excess fabric along each edge. Set your stitch length at 2.5 and sew the (TRP) Lines on each layout sheet. After the (TRP) lines are sewn, trim the threads on the front and backside of each fabric section.


Step 3: Trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of each Sec. Temp. Cut on Cut Line 1 to separate the templates into individual pieces. Templates G1-2 are placed with Unit G1 and the Templates G2-2 with Unit G2 in Bag \#G1.


Fabric G4 \& G6: (TLS) \#3, \#7, \#6 \& \#10
NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster App, each 4-1/2" strip is sub-cut into (2) 2-1/4" strips to achieve the \#of strips listed in Step 1.
Step 1: Cut (4) 2-1/4" by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips from each Fabric G4 \& G6. Stack the strips facing right-side up into two groups. Place (2) ea. Fabric G6 on the bottom and (2) ea. Fabric G4 on the top in each stack.


Step 2: Position Unit G3 (TLS \#7 \& \#3) are aligned with the left edge
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
