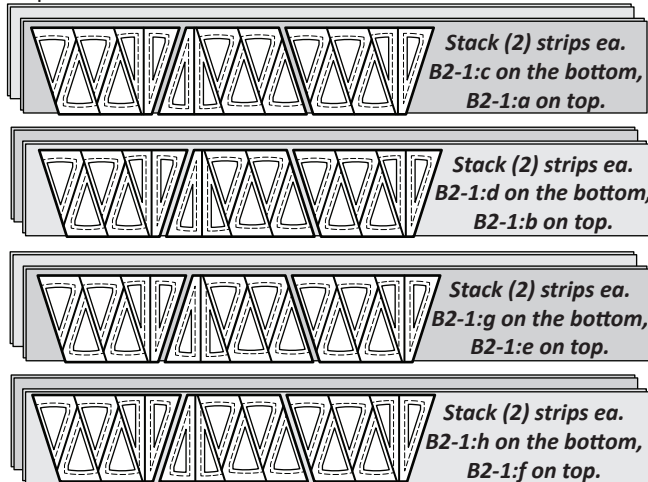


► Fabric B2-1: (TLS) #1 (Eight Color Option)

Step 1: The strips are stacked facing *right-side-up* into (4) Color Groups.



Step 2: Unit B2, Template Layout Sheet #1 is used to sub-cut (6) pieces from each color, matching the size and shape of the (TLS).



NOTE - If working with (2 or 4) colors, cut (4) pieces from each strip, instead of (3).

Step 3: The fabric pieces are sorted by color, then stacked twelve deep into (4) groups. If you are working with (8) colors, two color groups are stacked beneath (1) Template Layout Sheet.

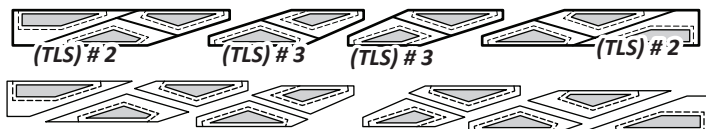


Step 4: To complete the cutting, slice through the paper and fabric on each Cut Line. Clip the pieces together and place into the assigned Color Group Bags.



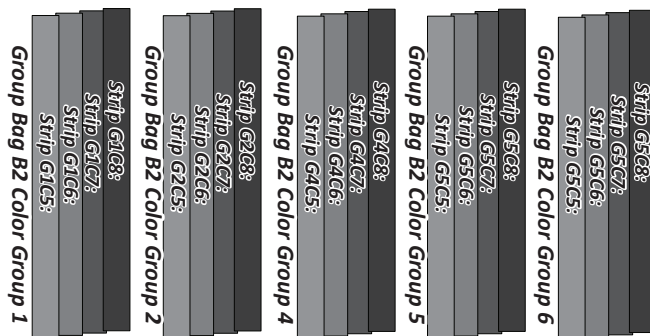
► Preparing (TLS) #2 & #3

Unit B2 (TLS #2) and (TLS #3) are cut apart on Cut Lines 1 & 2, to separate the individual Sec. Temps on each layout sheet, prior to cutting out your fabrics. Each Sec. Temp is assigned to a different Fabric #s B2-2:(a to e). Each strip yields (8) Sec. Templates for this layout you will only need to cut (6) pieces per template. Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template makes it easier to reposition the templates for multiple cuts.



► Sorting the Strips for Strip Set #1 & #2

In *Block Group Bag B2*, you should have two groups with (20) strips stacked in the order shown. These strips are now rearranged to create (4) new color groups including (5) strips ranging from lightest to darkest.



► New Color Groups

After the strips are sorted, the strips in each Color Group are labeled, Fabric B2-2:a to B2-2:e. Repeat the sorting process for the strips from Strip Set #2.
