

Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (4) bags to complete the organization for these instructions. Label the bags to stay organized.

- Bag #C1L: (4) Unit C1L and Cutting Templates
- Bag #C1R: (4) Unit C1R and Cutting Templates
- Bag #C2L: (4) ea. Unit C2L C3L, C4L, C6L, and (20) ea. C5L, (1) T-Template CL-1 and Cutting Templates
- Bag #C2R: (4) ea. Unit C2R, C3R, C4R, C6R, and (20) ea. C5R, (1) T-Template CR-1 and Cutting Templates

▶ Preparing the Foundation Papers:


Step 1: Cut out the Foundation Papers and place them in the appropriate bags as shown in the following graphics. Sort and stack the associated Templates, T-Templates and Template Layout Sheets (TLS) on [NP 843, NP 844, TP 653, TP 654, and TP 655] in numerical order and place into a temporary bag. After the fabric has been cut, the individual Templates, T-Temp, and Sec. Templates from the (TLS) are placed into assigned Bag #s with their associated foundation papers. *Refer back to General Information Booklet for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.







Rainbow Peaks Border Fabric Information:

We have provided you with a Unit Chart on the following page. The Unit Chart includes yardage, fabric numbers, and a reference to which fabrics go with each of the (TLS) to complete Units C1L-C6L and C1R-C6R. The Color Layout on the next pages shows a visual reference to where the fabrics are located on each unit.







► Fabric C1: TEMP C1L-1 & C1R-1

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Step 1: From Fabric C1, cut (2) 11-1/2" x 42" strips and stack them right-side up.

Step 2: Use the Unit C1L Sec 1 Template C1L-1 and Unit C1R Sec 1 Template C1R-1 to cut (4) fabric pieces the size of each Template Layout Sheet repositioning as shown.
