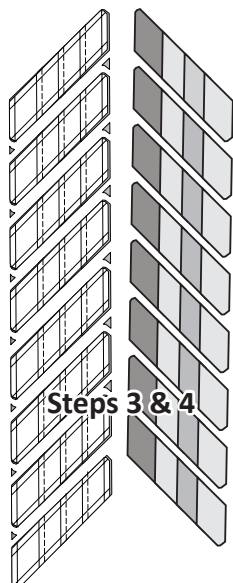


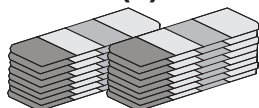
**Step 3:** The strips sets are now separated into (8) rows. Find the lines referred to as **Part 2, Cut Lines 1 through 7**. Using your ruler and rotary cutter, cut on each of the center lines to complete the cutting for each row.

**Step 4:** Trim off the tips to complete the cutting for all the smart corners.

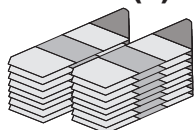
**Step 5:** Clip the pieces for each row together and set aside as shown below. Repeat Steps 1-5 to complete the cutting on the remaining strip sets.



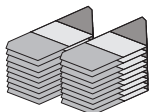
► **Unit T4: Two Sets of (8)**



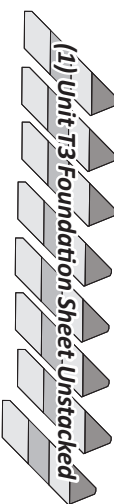
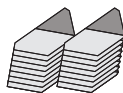
► **Unit T3: Two Sets of (8)**



► **Unit T2: Two Sets of (8) (Unstacked Graphic not shown)**

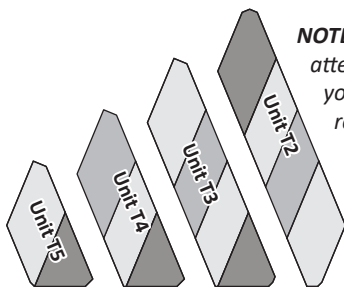


► **Unit T1: Two Set of (8) (Unstacked Graphic not shown)**



## ASSEMBLE THE DIAMONDS

**Step 1:** Arrange the colors for each strip into the order they will be sewn together. One each of Units T2, T3, T4, and T5, are joined to complete (1) star point. There are (16) Star Points in this pattern.



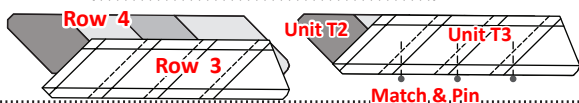
**NOTE - Color Orientation:** Pay very close attention to the color orientation. Check your strips, make sure the colors and rows are positioned correctly before you sew the strip sets together.

**NOTE - Making Corrections:** If you find a color has been sewn in the wrong position, it's not too late to fix it. The pieces at this point have been trimmed down to the size you would have cut them if you had been making this quilt without foundation paper. To fix any mistakes, pick out the stitches, rearrange the diamonds, and sew the pieces back together.

Repeat Steps 1-10 for each star point.

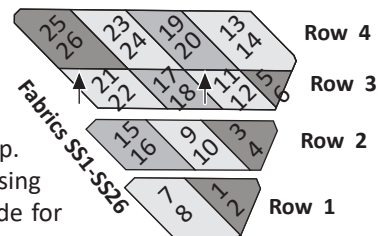
**Step 2:** Position Unit T3, (Row-3) onto the top of Unit T2, (Row-4), with both strips facing **right-sides together**. Match and pin each intersection where the sew lines cross on your foundation paper.

**RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER**



**Step 3:** Once the pieces are pinned together, remove the foundation papers under the sections on **Row-4** without disturbing the pins.

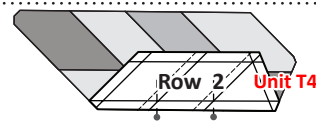
**Step 4:** At your machine, place **Unit T4** on the bottom next to the feed dogs, leaving Unit T3 on top. Sew both strips together using the quarter-inch line as a guide for stitching.



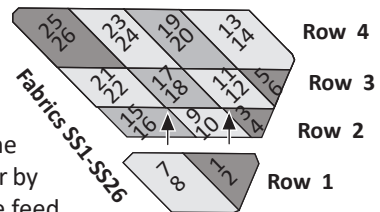
**Step 5:** The seam is pressed facing towards Row-4 as shown with the arrows in **Step 4**.

**Step 6:** Position Unit T4 (Row-2) onto the top of Units T4/T3, (Rows-3 & 4), **right-sides together**. Match and pin both pieces at each quarter-inch intersection.

**RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER**

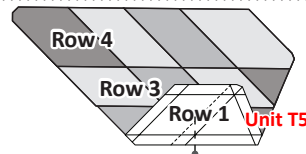


**Step 7:** Once again, remove the foundation papers under **Unit T3**, (Row-3) without disturbing the pins. After removing the paper, sew both strips together by positioning **Unit T3** next to the feed dogs. When the sewing is complete press the seam towards Row-3.



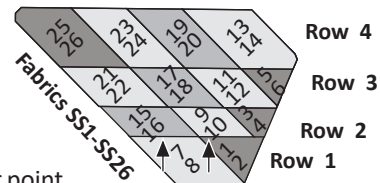
**Step 8:** Position Unit T5, (Row-1) onto the top of Units T2/T3/T4 (Rows 2-4) with **right-sides together**. Match and pin both pieces together at each cross-section.

**RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER**



**Step 9:** Remove the foundation papers under **Row-2** without disturbing the pins. Then sew both strips together with **Row-2** next to the feed dogs.

**Step 10:** To finished the star, press the seam towards Row-2.



Repeat Steps 1-10 for each star point.

## ASSEMBLING THE 10" CENTER BLOCKS

**Foundation Paper:** Remove the foundation paper from any of the remaining pieces.

**Step 1:** The blocks are sewn together in the order shown in the following Block Layouts. The graphics were drawn as if you were looking at the front side of the fabric. The pieces are sewn together with right-sides facing together. The Template and Unit Placement is shown here.
