

## ► Standard Color Layout: Fabrics D1 & D2



## ► Alternative 1 Color Layout: Fabric D1 through D9



**Color Layout Information:** The *Standard Color Layout* and cutting instruction are designed with two colors. If you are using multiple colors, reference the *Alternative 1 Color Layout*. Fabric D1 is referenced as one color in both layouts.

**NOTE - D1 Color Option:** If you are cutting your fabrics using the Alternative 1, (9) Color Option, Complete the cutting instructions for Fabric D1 below then jump to The Alternative 1, cutting Instructions for Fabric D2-D9.

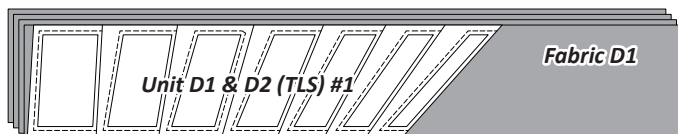
## STANDARD CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### ► Fabric D1: (TLS #1, #2)

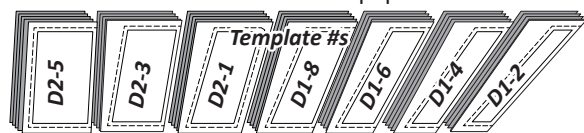
**NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 14-1/2" strip into (2) 7-1/4" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.**

**Step 1:** Cut (8) 7-1/4" by 42" strips from Fabric D1. The strips are stacked facing *right-side up* into (2) groups of (4) strips.

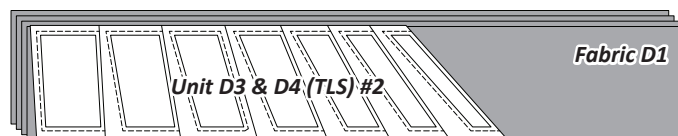
**Step 2:** Units D1 & D2 (TLS #1) is placed with the first stack. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the layout sheet.



**Step 3:** Clip the section templates to the fabric beneath, then complete the cutting on each Cut Line, 1 thru 6, to separate the individual templates. Place the *Unit D1 & D2* template pieces in Bag D1 with their associated foundation papers.



**Step 4:** Units D3 & D4 (TLS #2) is placed with the second stack. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the layout sheet.



**Step 5:** Clip the section templates to the fabric beneath, then complete the cutting on each Cut Line, 1 thru 6, to separate the individual templates. Place the *Unit D3 & D4* template pieces in Bag D2 with their associated foundation papers.

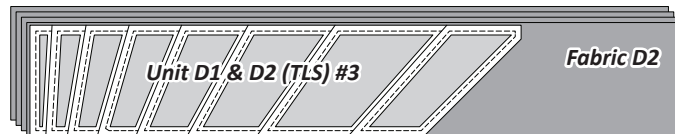


### ► Fabric D2: (TLS #3, #4)

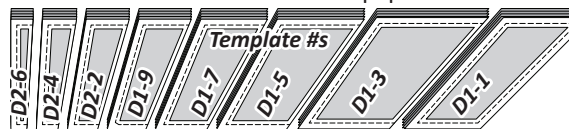
**NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 14-1/2" strip into (2) 7-1/4" strips.**

**Step 6:** Cut (8) 7-1/4" by 42" strips from Fabric D2. The strips are stacked facing *right-side up* into (2) groups of (4) strips.

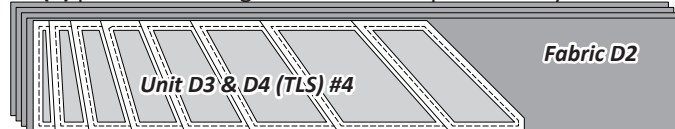
**Step 7:** Units D1 & D2 (TLS #3) is placed with the first stack. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the layout sheet.



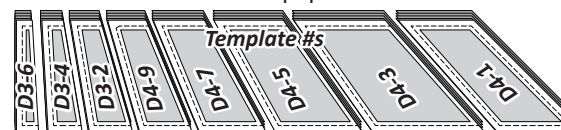
**Step 8:** Clip the section templates to the fabric beneath, then complete the cutting on each Cut Line, 1 thru 7, to separate the individual templates. Place the *Unit D1 & D2* template pieces in Bag D1 with their associated foundation paper.



**Step 9:** Units D3 & D4 (TLS #2) is placed with the second stack. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the layout sheet.



**Step 10:** Clip the section templates to the fabric beneath, then complete the cutting on each Cut Line, 1 thru 7, to separate the individual templates. Place the *Unit D4* template pieces in Bag D1 with their associated foundation papers.



## ALTERNATIVE 1 CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: FABRICS D2-D9

**Preparing the Templates:** Before you cut the D2-D9 fabric pieces, you need to pre-cut both (TLS) #3 & #4, on each **Cut Lines 1 to 7** to separate Sec. Temps use to cut your fabrics. Keep the templates paired and organized in numerical order as you cut them apart. The section templates on (TLS) #3 are paired with the section templates on (TLS) #4. Example:

- *Sec 1, Temp D1-1*, is paired with, *Sec 1, Temp D4-1*
