



QUILT ASSEMBLY

Remove any remaining foundation paper from all the units at this time. Set your machine to sew a quarter-inch seam allowance. Reference the Layout Newsprints LP 106 & LP 107 for the Assembly Graphics 1 to 10. The graphics on both LP Sheets are shown assuming you would be looking at the front side of the quilt.

Assembly Graphic 1: The pieces in Groups J, K, L, M, and D are arranged on a design wall as shown on the next page.

Assembly Graphic 2: Join the M Group to the D Group.

- Join MR on the diagonal to D6. Press seams away from MR.
- Join ML on the vertical and horizontal to D4. Press seams toward ML.
- Join MR on the vertical and horizontal to D3. Press seams away from MR.
- Join ML on the diagonal to D1. Press seams toward ML.

Assembly Graphic 3: Join the L Group to the M/D Group.

- Join Short L-Left to D6/MR. Press seams toward Short L-Left.
- Join Long L-Left to D4/ML. Press seams away from Long L-Left.
- Join Long L-Right to D3/MR. Press seams toward Long L-Right.
- Join Short L-Right to D1/ML. Press seams away from Short L-Right.

Assembly Graphic 4: Add the K Group pieces on the diagonal and add Group D pieces.

- Join (4) KR on the diagonal to D6/MR/Short L-Left. Press seams away from KR.
- Join (4) KL on the diagonal D1/ML/Short L-Right. Press seams toward KL.
- Join D5 to D4/ML/Long L-Left. Press seams away from D5.
- Join D2 to D3/MR/Long L-Right. Press seams toward D2.

Assembly Graphic 5: Finish joining the K Group pieces on the horizontal and vertical and add Group J.

- Join (4) Group J to D6/MR/Short L-Left/KR. Press seams toward Group J.
- Join (4) Group J to D1/ML/Short L-Right/KL. Press seams away from Group J.
- Join (4) KL to D5/D4/ML/Long L-Left. Press seams toward KL.
- Join (4) KR to D2/D3/MR/Long L-Right. Press seams away from KR.

Assembly Graphic 6: Continue to join the center blocks into larger wedges, pressing the seams in a clockwise direction looking at the front of the quilt.

- Join (4) D6/MR/Short L-Left/KR/J blocks to the D5/D4/ML/Long L-Left/KL blocks.
- Join (4) D3/D2/MR/Long L-Right/KR blocks to the D1/ML/Short L-Right/KL/J blocks.

Assembly Graphic 7: Sew the (4) D8 and D9 on to their respective blocks groups, and press away from D8 and D9.

- Join (4) D9 to the left J/K/L/M/D group.
- Join (4) D8 blocks to the right J/K/L/M/D group.

Joining these units requires a little extra explanation. First, the pieces must be joined right sides together. Match the smart corners at both end points, then apply the glue along the curved edges within the boundary of the seam allowance to keep the raw edges from slipping in the sewing process. Start sewing on the edge closest to the center of the quilt. **Block group D9** (or D8) will be on the bottom next to the feed dogs and rest of the large quilt section will be on the top.

Assembly Graphic 8: Sew the (4) D10 and D7 blocks on to their respective blocks to create (8) wedges. Press away from D10 and D7.

- Join (4) D10 blocks onto the left block group.
- Join (4) D7 blocks on to the right block group.

The same curved piecing process described above should be used to add **block groups** D7 and D10. The D7 and D10 groups will be on the bottom, next to the feed dogs. Sew from the edge closest to the center of the group out to the diagonal wedge.

Assembly Graphic 9: Sew the wedges together on the vertical and horizontal seams creating (4) triangles. Press the seams in a clockwise direction when looking at the front of the quilt.

Assembly Graphic 10: Sew the final (4) seams together to complete the quilt. Press the seams in a clockwise direction when looking at the front of the quilt.
