**Assembly Graphic 4:** Sew the diagonal seams together and press in the directions of the arrows to complete the guilt.

Final Intersection Pressing: Pick back a couple stitches at the end of each seam where the seams join in the center of the star. Tweak the seams in opposing directions before pressing on the backside of the fabric.

## QUILTING DESIGNS

Quiltworx.com has completed a quilting design for Autumn Splendor. To find it, visit the pattern page and check the Related Products. To find it guickly, scan the QR Code for the pattern on the back page. Quiltworx.com recommends Hobbs 80/20 batting or similar to get a nice, thin, but flexible finish to the quilt.

### DOUBLE FOLDED BINDING INFORMATION

After the quilt top has been quilted, you can add the binding. Quiltworx.com recommends a 2-1/2" strip, ironed in half, lengthwise, then sewn to the front of the quilt and hand stitched down to the backside.

## EXPANDING YOUR QUILT

There are a few options for expanding your Autumn Splendor. First, you can simply make more blocks. We do not have yardage figured out for this option, nor do we have a Quiltster layout for it, but it is always something you could do. Note that we don't have replacement papers for sale for this pattern as it is a limited edition Collector's Club Design. so, you would need to either purchase a second pattern or call the office to order in papers as a custom order and figure out what you need.

#### ► Adding a Border to get to 68" Square

The JNQ00242-C borders can be used to expand this quilt to a 68" square quilt. You are free to choose your preferred border. Note that there is an assembly graphic on LP 108 that shows when the 57" to 68" border should be added to the quilt. Press the seams towards the border. This option is available for you to explore in Quiltster. Please note, if you do this option, you will have multiple fabric references referred to as "C" because of the Unit C blocks in the original pattern, and the C-Borders. Follow the By Group Yardage and pay special attention to cutting information to sort through which fabrics belong where. Once you have them sorted, make sure you only work on one section at a time.

# Adding a Queen Size Border to get to 99" Square

This option requires that you first add a 57" to 68" border of your choosing, then you can choose a JNQ00242-D border of your choosing. Turn the 68" quilt on point, and follow the directions in the Queen Border booklet to make your quilt. On LP 108, there is a graphic that explains how to complete your Queen border assembly, then add that to one quarter of the quilt. Complete all (4) corners the same way. On the cover of the pattern, a Queen example was provided. This version uses the 242-C Satin and Lace border, and the 242-D Geese Migrations Border. Yardage for the version shown on the coversheet is provided in the table to

the right if you are interested in simply following the design we provided as an example.

### ▶ Other Expansion Options

There are still other ways you could expand this guilt, although these options are not available in Quiltster for you to explore. First, you could make any of our 10" square blocks and switch them out or add them on to get a different look to this guilt and make it bigger. Check out our 10" square Charm Elements for more possibilities.

You can also add a JNQ00281-D border to a 68" quilt, to get to 80" square. From there, any of the JNQ00277-H borders would work to take this quilt to King.
