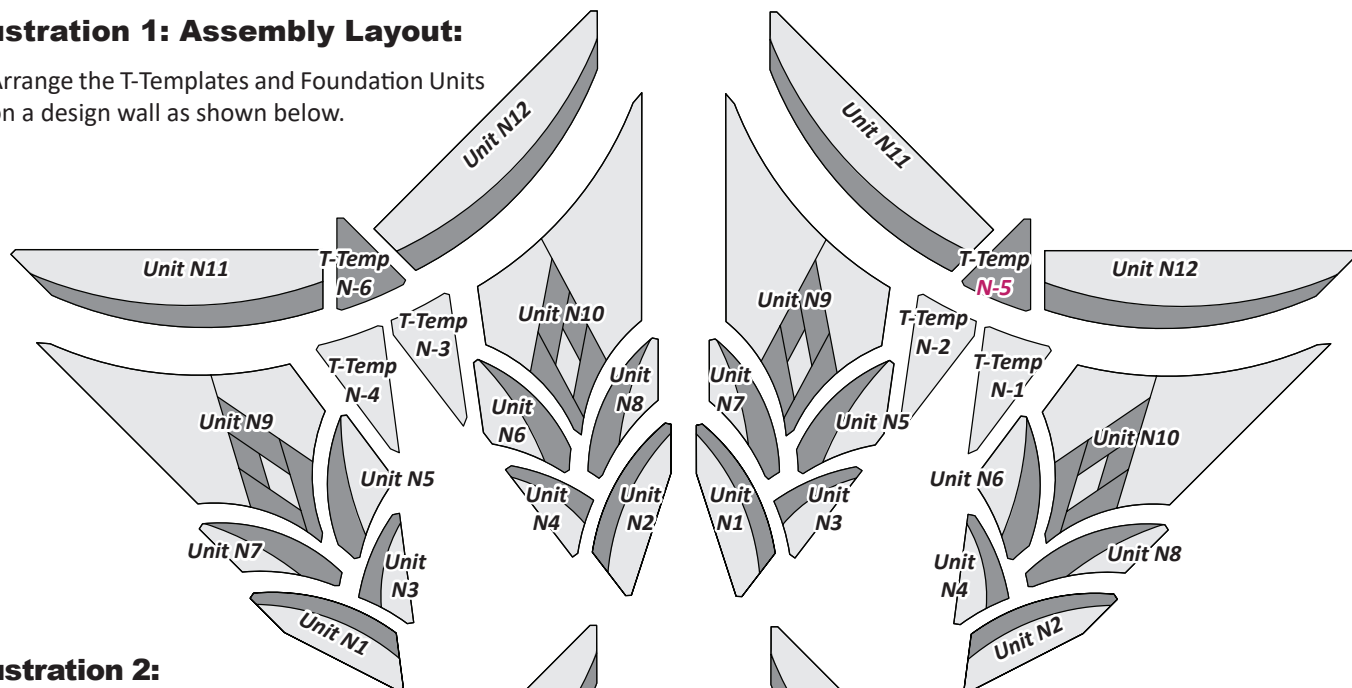


► Illustration 1: Assembly Layout:

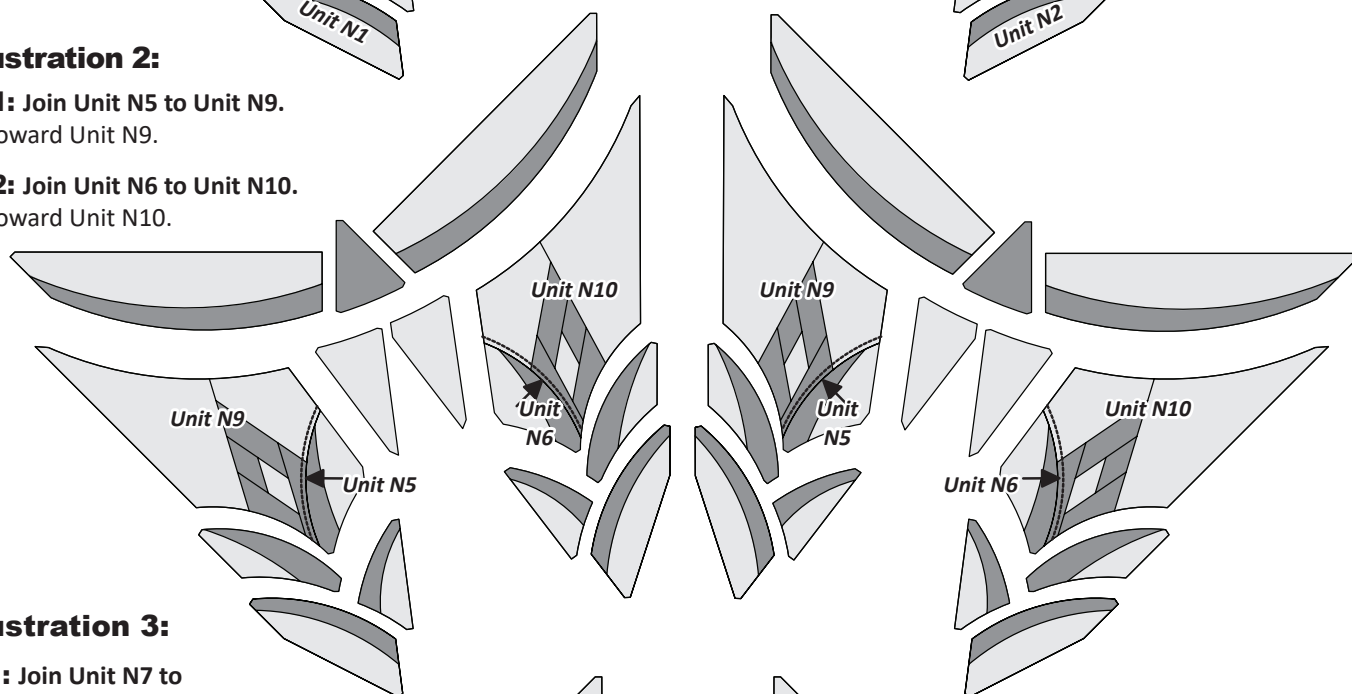
- Arrange the T-Templates and Foundation Units on a design wall as shown below.



► Illustration 2:

Step 1: Join Unit N5 to Unit N9.
Press toward Unit N9.

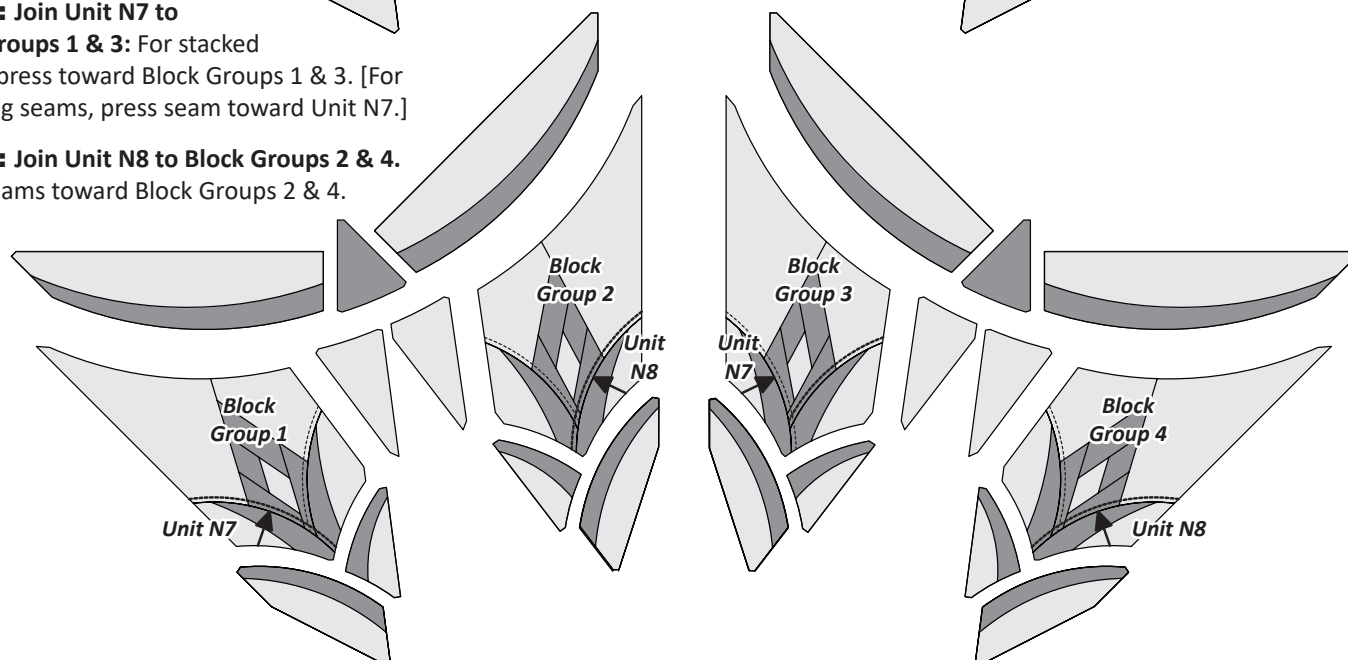
Step 2: Join Unit N6 to Unit N10.
Press toward Unit N10.



► Illustration 3:

Step 1: Join Unit N7 to Block Groups 1 & 3: For stacked seams, press toward Block Groups 1 & 3. [For opposing seams, press seam toward Unit N7.]

Step 2: Join Unit N8 to Block Groups 2 & 4.
Press seams toward Block Groups 2 & 4.



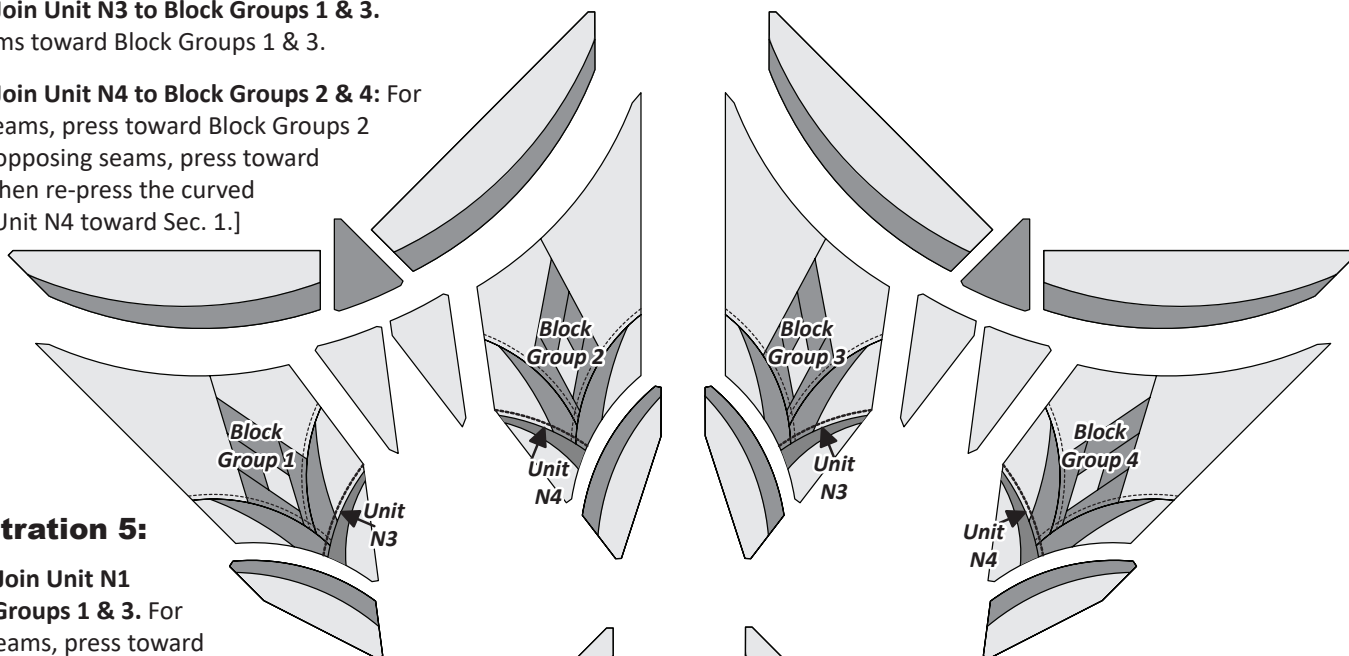
► Illustration 4:

Step 1: Join Unit N3 to Block Groups 1 & 3.

Press seams toward Block Groups 1 & 3.

Step 2: Join Unit N4 to Block Groups 2 & 4:

For stacked seams, press toward Block Groups 2 & 4. [For opposing seams, press toward Unit N4, then re-press the curved seam on Unit N4 toward Sec. 1.]



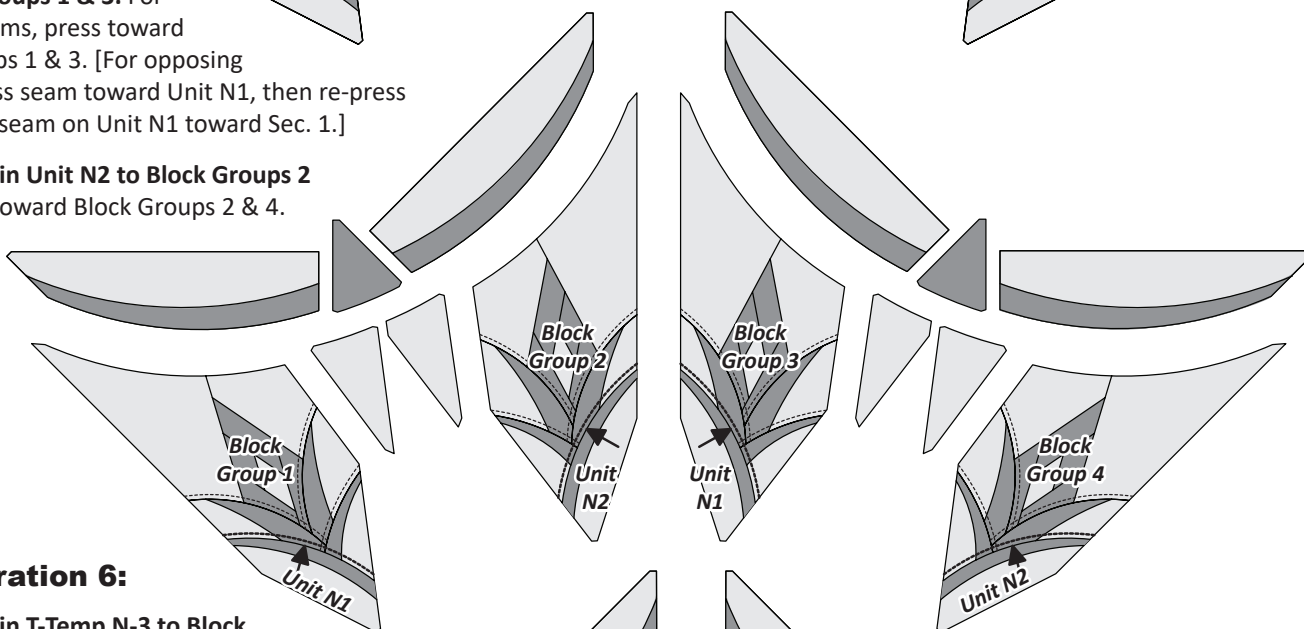
► Illustration 5:

Step 1: Join Unit N1

to Block Groups 1 & 3. For stacked seams, press toward Block Groups 1 & 3. [For opposing seams, press seam toward Unit N1, then re-press the curved seam on Unit N1 toward Sec. 1.]

Step 2: Join Unit N2 to Block Groups 2

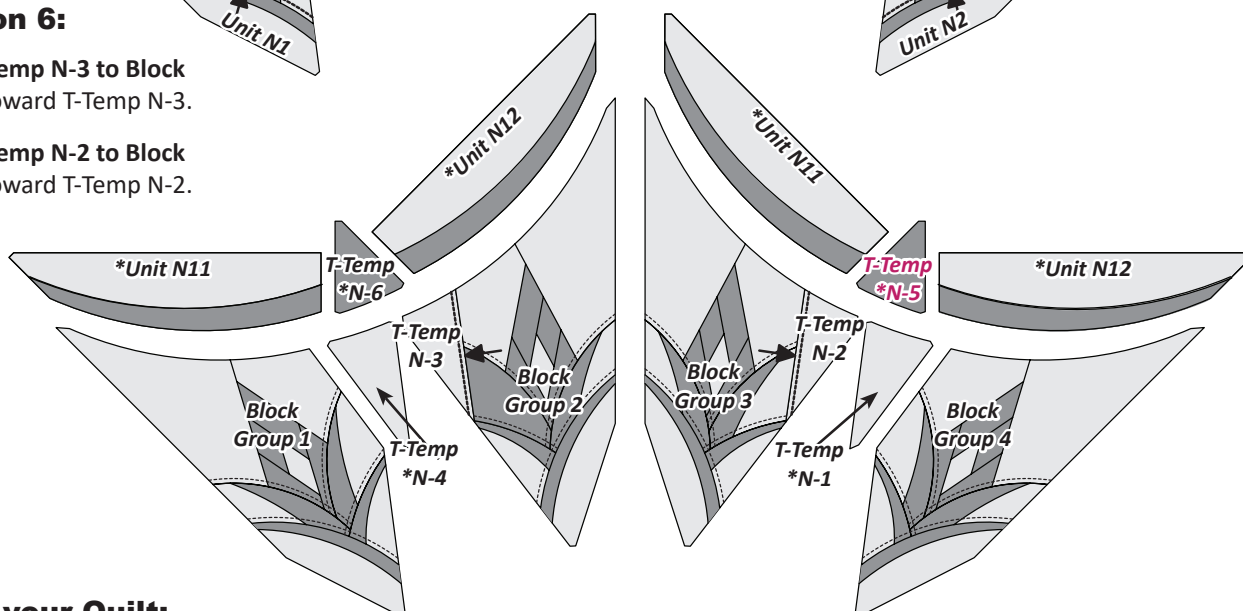
& 4. Press toward Block Groups 2 & 4.



► Illustration 6:

Step 1: Join T-Temp N-3 to Block Group 2. Press toward T-Temp N-3.

Step 2: Join T-Temp N-2 to Block Group 3. Press toward T-Temp N-2.



► Finishing your Quilt:

To avoid Y-seams in the assembly process the remaining *Block Groups and *T-Templates are NOT joined at this time.
