## - Bridal Bouquet Border Fabric Information:

The table includes yardage, fabric numbers, and a reference to which fabrics go with the Templates and (TLS) to complete Units D1R-D4R and D1L-D4L. The table is your guide for not only selecting your own colors, but keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the

Assigned Colors column! The color layout at the bottom of the page provides a visual reference to the assigned Fabric \#s on each unit. If you are using different fabrics for D1:a \& D1:b and D2:a \& D2:b, pay attention to where those fabrics are used.

## GROUP D CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE - Stacking Strips: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned on the strips to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct \# of pieces are stacked beneath each Template or (TLS) before cutting.

NOTE - Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the templates and (TLS) from moving in the cutting process.

## Fabrics D1:a \& D1:b: (TLS) \#1 \& \#2

NOTE - Quiltster: If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 13" strip into (2) 6-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (4) 6-1/2" by 42" strips each from Fabrics D1:a and D1:b. Stack the strips facing right-side-up, in (2) stacks of fabric with (2) strips each from Fabrics D1:a and D1:b.


Step 2: Position Unit D1R (TLS) \#1 on the first stack of (4) strips. Slide the layout sheets as far to the bottom left corner as possible. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the (TLS). Reposition the (TLS) along the top right edge and cut (4) additional pieces.
