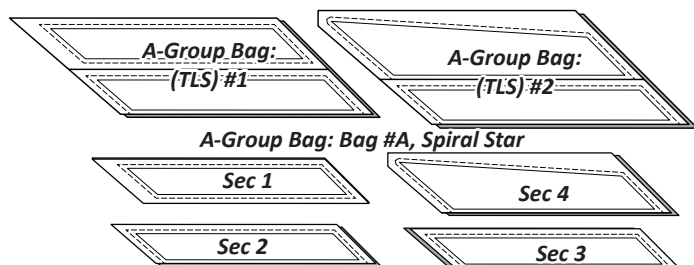
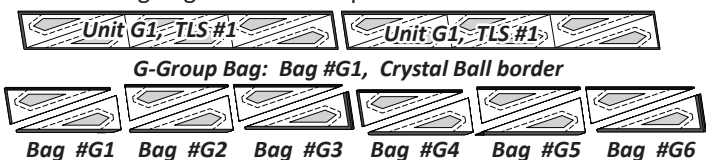


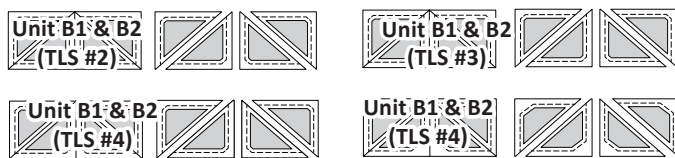
Step 3: Unit A1-A4 (TLS) #1 and (TLS #2): Cut (1) stack for each (TLS) from Fabric S1-S8. Complete the cutting on Cut Line 1 for each (TLS). Clip the templates to the fabric beneath, without changing the stacking order. Place these pieces into the Group A Bag.



Step 4: Unit G1, (TLS #2): Cut (2) stacks from Fabric S1-S8, one for each (TLS). Complete the cutting on each Cut Line 1-5. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath and place the G1 Templates in the following Bags #s with Group G.



Step 5: Unit B1 & B2, (TLS #2, #3, #4, & #5) are cut apart on Cut Lines 1-3 to separate the individual Sec Temp, prior to cutting the fabric. This is done because only (1) template is used for each Sec #.

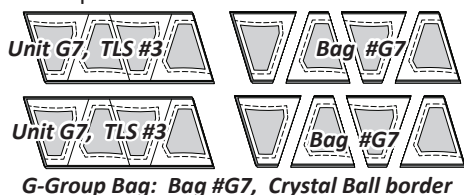


Step 6: Once the (TLS) are cut apart, locate (1) ea. **Temp B1-3, B1-5, B1-7, B1-9, B2-3, B2-5, B2-7, & B2-9.** Cut (1) stack for each template from Fabrics S1-S8. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath and place the B1 Templates in Bag #B1 and the B2 Templates in Bag #B2, with Group B.



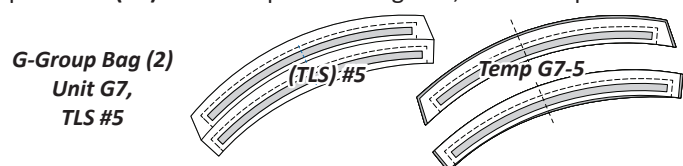
B-Group Bag: Bag #B1 & Bag #B2, Fat Feathered Border

Step 7: Unit G7, (TLS #3): Cut (2) stacks, from Fabric S1-S8 (1) for each (TLS). Complete the cutting on each Cut Line 1-3. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath and place the G7 Templates in Bag #G7, for Group G.



G-Group Bag: Bag #G7, Crystal Ball border

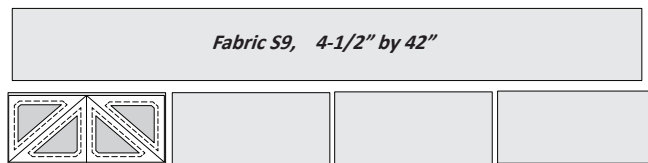
Step 8: Unit G7, (TLS #5): Cut (1) stack. Complete the cutting on each Cut Line 1. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath and place the (16) G7-5 Templates in Bag #G7, with Group G.



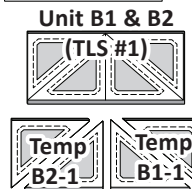
► Fabric S9: Unit B1 & B2 (TLS) #1

Step 1: Cut (1) 4-1/2" by 42" strip and (2) 4" by 42" strips from Fabric S9.

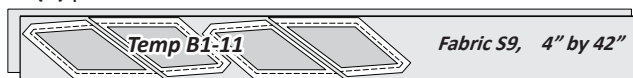
Step 2: Place the 4-1/2" strip facing **right-side-up.** **Unit B1 & B2 (TLS #1)** is used to sub-cut (4) pieces matching the size of the (TLS).



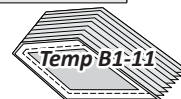
Step 3: Stack the (4) rectangles beneath the (TLS). Complete the cutting on each Cut Line 1-3. Place the Unit B1 templates in Bag #B1 and the Unit B2 templates in Bag #B2 with Group B.



Step 4: Stack the (2) 4" by 42" strips facing **right-side-up.** **Unit B1 Temp B1-11** is used to cut (8) pieces.



Step 5: Place the Unit B1 templates in Bag #B1 with Group B.

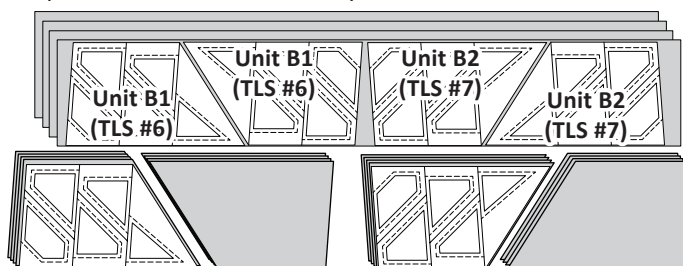


► Fabric S10:

- Cut (4) 7" by 42" strips from Fabric S10. Place these strips with Unit B1 & B2 (TLS #6 & TLS #7).
- Cut (6) 17" by 42" strips from Fabric S10. Place these strips with Units G1 thru G6 (TLS #1).
- Cut (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric S10. Place these strips with Unit G7 (TLS #1).

► Units B1 & B2 (TLS #6 & #7)

Step 1: Stack the (4) 7" by 42" strips cut from Fabric S10 facing **right-side-up** on your table. **Unit B1 & B2 (TLS) #6 & #7,** are used to cut (8) pieces matching the size of each (TLS). Reposition the templates as needed for each layout sheet.



Step 2: Stack the (8) pieces beneath each (TLS). Completed the cutting on each Cut Line 1-5 to separate the individual sections. Paper clip the templates to the fabric beneath. The Unit B1 Templates are placed in Bag #B1 and Unit B2 Templates in Bag #B2, Group Bag B.
