Step 3: Line the edge of the fold template up with Line 1. Fold the

paper back over the top of the fold template.

Step 4: Place the Add-A-Quarter ruler against the edge of the folded back section on the paper, lip-side down, and trim the fabric with your rotary cutter.

Step 7: Loosen the glue under Sec. 1, then flip the paper over and press the fabric on the backside of the paper as shown.


> Step 8: Line the edge of the fold template up on Line 2. Tear the paper along the stitches on Line 1 (where it is circled in the graphic)

to fold the paper back over the fold template. When you hit the fold template, stop!

Step 9: Trim the fabric with the Add-A-Quarter ruler.


Step 10: Find the third piece of fabric and position it beneath your foundation paper, lining up the sew-side with the raw

edge of the trimmed quarter-inch seam allowance. Open the paper and sew on Line 2, then press the seam open on the front side.
