


## GROUP D: WAGON WHEELS QUEEN BORDER INSTRUCTIONS

**Ziploc Storage Bags:** You will need (5) bags to complete the organization for these instructions. Label the bags as follows to stay organized while cutting the Foundation Units and Templates.


- Bag #D1: (4) ea. Unit D1 & D2 Foundation Papers
- Bag #D2: (4) ea. Unit D3 & D4 Foundation Papers
- Bag #D3: (16) Unit D5 Foundation Papers
- Bag #D4: (8) Unit D6 Foundation Papers
- Template Bag D: Templates & Template Layout Sheets (TLS)

### ► Preparing Foundation Papers & Templates:


Cut out (4) each of Units D1–D4 and Template Layout Sheets (TLS) #9 and #10, (16) of Unit D5, and (8) of Unit D6 [NP 861 & 862]. Cut out (2) each of Template Layout Sheets (TLS) #5 & #7 & #11–#14 [TP 685]. Cut out (1) each of T-Templates D-1, D-2, D-4, D-5, D-6, D-7, & D-8; (3) of T-Template D-3; and (1) each of Template Layout Sheets (TLS) #1–#4, #6, and #8 [TP 686 thru 688]. Place the foundation papers into the assigned Bag #D1–#D4 listed above. Sort templates and (TLS) in alphanumerical order and place in **Template Bag D**. After the fabrics have been cut, the Sec. Temps are placed with the foundation papers into their assigned Bag #s. Reference the newsprint graphics that follow for the location of each Unit, Template and TLS along with the associated Bag # if applicable. \*Refer back to General Information for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.





**Step 2:** Position *Unit D1, (TLS) #3* and *Unit D2, (TLS) #4* on the fabric stack, rotating and repositioning the (TLS) as shown to make each cut. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of each (TLS) #3 & #4.



**Step 3:** Stack the four fabric pieces under each (TLS) and cut the templates on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual pieces. Clip each section template to the fabric beneath. Place pieces into Bag #D1.



► **Fabric D3: (TLS) #7 & #8**

**Step 1:** Cut (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips from *Fabric D3* and stack facing *right-side up*.

**Step 2:** Position *Unit D3, (TLS) #7* and *Unit D4, (TLS) #8* on the fabric stack as shown. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of each (TLS) #7 & #8.



**Step 3:** Cut the templates on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual pieces. Clip each section template to the fabric beneath. Place pieces into Bag #D2.



► **Fabric D4: (TLS) #5 & #6**

**Step 1:** Cut (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips from *Fabric D4* and stack facing *right-side up*.

**Step 2:** Position *Unit D3, (TLS) #5* and *Unit D4, (TLS) #6* on the fabric stack as shown. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of each (TLS) #5 & #6.





**Step 3:** Cut the templates on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual pieces. Clip each section template to the fabric beneath. Place pieces into Bag #D2.




► **Fabric D5: (TLS) #9 & #10**

**Step 1:** Cut (1) 13-1/2" by 42" strip from *Fabric D5* and position facing *right-side up*.

**Step 2:** Use *Unit D3, (TLS) #9* and *Unit D4, (TLS) #10* to cut (2) of each (TLS) #9 and #10. [You will have (2) extra of each paper left over; discard].




**Step 3:** Cut templates on the *Cut Line* to separate the individual pieces. Sew the *TRP Lines* printed on each *Sec. Temp*. Clip each *Temp* to the fabric beneath and place the pieces into Bag #D2.



► **Fabric D6: T-Temps D-1, D-2 & D-3**

**Step 1:** Cut (4) 16" by 42" strips from *Fabric D6* and stack facing *right-side up*.

**Step 2:** Use *T-Temps D-1 & D-2* to cut (4) pieces each. Position the three *T-Temp D-3* papers on the strip and use to cut (16) pieces, repositioning one of the templates as needed.



**Step 3:** Sew the *TRP Lines* printed on each *T-Temp* using a basting stitch. Clip each *Temp* to the fabric beneath and place the pieces into Bag #D5.
