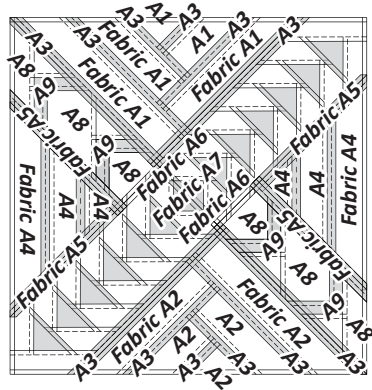


► **Color Layout**

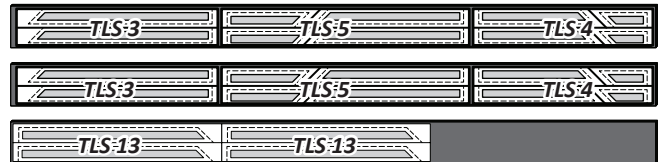


► **Fabric A3**

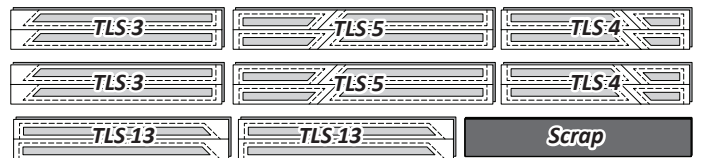
Step 1: Cut **(8)** 7-1/2" x 42" strips cut from Fabric A3 and stack, *right-side-up* on a cutting table. We suggest **(2)** stacks of **(8)** pieces to make it easier to cut through the layers.



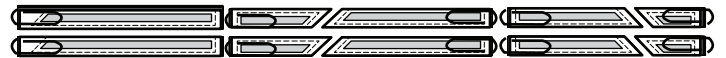
Step 2: Cut each stack into **(3)** 2-1/2" x 42" strip stacks. Cut **(2)** with the *Unit A1 TLS 3, 4, and 5*. Cut the third stack with *Unit A3, TLS 13*.



Step 3: Cut around the Template Layout Sheets.



Step 4: Then, place a paper clip on each section of the Template Layout Sheet to clip the Template to the fabrics beneath. Next, cut on the Cut Lines, in order, until you have cut all the individual sections apart. The TLS 3, 5, and 4 is shown as an example.

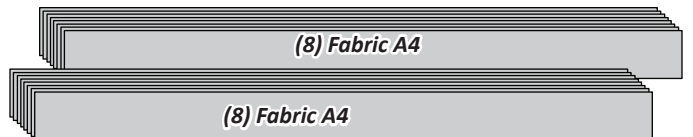


Step 5: Place the clipped sections for Unit A1 (*TLS 3, 4, and 5*) into Bag #A1. Place the clipped pieces for Unit A3 into Bag A3 (*TLS 13*).

► **UNIT A2 CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAG #A2**

► **Fabric A4:**

Step 1: Cut **(16)** 2-1/2" x 42" strips. In the cover quilt, we cut these all from the same fabric, but if you would like to do this out of 2-1/2" strips in different colors, you can. One 2-1/2" strip makes **(2)** Unit A2, which is enough for each of the Group A 20" squares in this pattern. We suggest stacking these into **(2)** stacks of **(8)** 2-1/2" strips, right-side up, to help with cutting through all the layers of fabric.

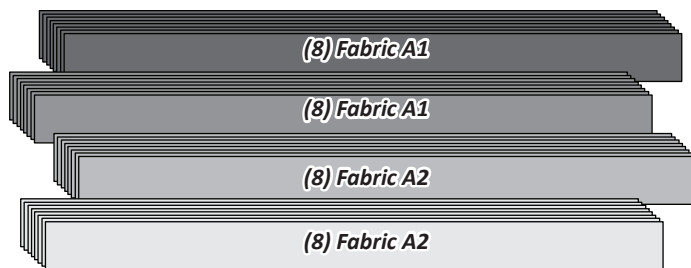


► **UNIT A1 CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, BAG #A1**

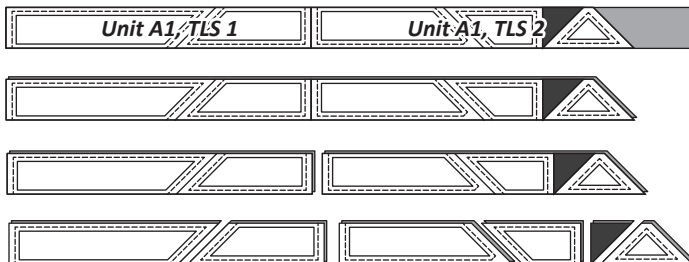
► **Fabrics A1 and A2:**

In this option, all of the pieces sewn into each Unit A1 will be from a different fabric since we suggest using 2-1/2" Quiltworx Strip sets with **(48)** strips. You will need the lightest **(32)** strips for this step. If you do not plan to use the Quiltworx Strip set, you can make these all from the same fabric, or any combination of different fabrics you like.

Step 1: Stack the 2-1/2" strips into **(4)** stacks of **(8)**. Order does not matter, however if you have specific colors identified for Fabrics A1 and A2, you might find it helpful to keep the fabrics separate so that **(2)** of the stack include the **(16)** pieces for Fabric A1 and **(2)** stacks include the **(16)** pieces for Fabric A2.



Step 2: Place **(1)** set of *Unit A1 TLS 1 and 2* onto each stack as shown. Clip the Templates to the Strips so they will not move, then cut between the Templates until they are cut apart.



Step 3: Place the stacks into Bag #A1. If you have special fabrics for A1 and A2, you may want to label your A2 Templates to stay organized.
