


► **Preparing the Foundation Papers:**

Step 1: Cut out (72) Unit A [NP 955]. Place (6) Unit A in each Bag #A1 to #A6. Cut out (8) each TLS #1, #2, and #3 on [TP 767] and place all of them into the Template Bag. See the newsprint graphics that follow for information on how to organize your units and templates into bags. *Refer back to General Information for Foundation Papers and Templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.




► **Unit A Fabric Information:**

The Unit Chart includes, fabric numbers, and a reference to which fabrics go with the Templates and (TLS) for Unit A. This table is your guide for not only selecting your own colors, but keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the boxes in the Assigned Color column!

► **Color Layout**

Make (72)




NOTE - Backside Graphic: The Fabric References above are shown from the backside of the quilt, or the printed side of the paper. This will make it easy to visualize how to put a swatch on each of the unit to keep track of where your fabrics go. For a front-side reference see the graphic on Page 15.


► **Fabric A1, TLS #1**

Step 1: Stack (2) 3" x 42" strips cut from each of the (12) Fabrics for A1. Stack this in the Row order as outlined on Page 5, **right-side-up** into (2) separate stacks so it's easier to cut.


Unit A, Make (72)		
GROUP-A FABRIC #	YARDAGE INCH	ASSIGNED COLOR
Fabric A1 Unit A (TLS #1)	2 yd or (72") (24) 3" Strips	Fabric Swatch
Fabric A2 Unit A (TLS #2)	(24) 2-1/2" Strips	Fabric Swatch
Fabric A3 Unit A (TLS #3)	(24) 2-1/2" Strips	Fabric Swatch



Step 2: Place (3) Unit A TLS #1 onto the top of each stack, beginning at the left edge. Only one stack is shown in the graphic. The other is done the same. Cut around the TLS, then reposition it, cutting (4) stacks with (9) pieces from each Fabric.



Step 3: Re-stack into (12) stacks of (6), by color. Place a TLS #1 on top of each stack, then cut them apart on the cut lines. You only have (8) TLS, so you will need to reuse some of your Templates for the last (4) stacks. Clip each stack of triangles together and place (1) stack of fabric into each Bag #A1 to #A12.



► **Fabric A2, TLS #2**

Step 1: You should already have all your strips cut into 2-1/2" x 42" strips. Stack (2) strips of Fabric A2 from Row 1-1 on top of A2 from Row 1-2. Continue, stacking the strips, for each row, in the same way, facing **right-side-up**. You will need a total of (24) 2-1/2" x 42" strips.
