

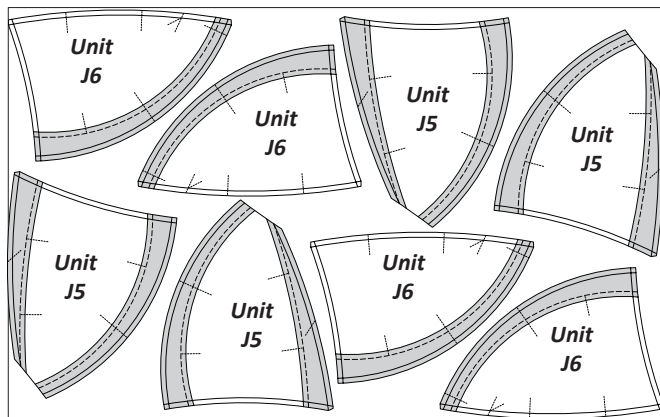
GROUP J: STARFISH CLAMSHELL INSTRUCTIONS

Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need **(4)** large bags and **(4)** medium bags to organize the block groups for this project. Label each bag as follows. Place the **(4)** medium bags in Bag #11 with the Foundation Sheets for Units J1, J2, J3 & J4.

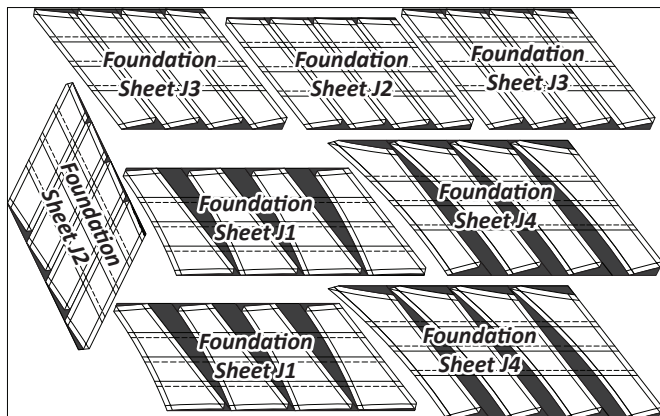
- Bag #J1: **(2)** each of Foundation Sheets J1, J2, J3 & J4
- Bag #J2: **(8)** of Unit J5 Foundation Papers
- Bag #J3: **(8)** of Unit J6 Foundation Papers
- Template Bag J: Temporary Bag for Template Storage

► Preparing Foundation Papers & Templates:

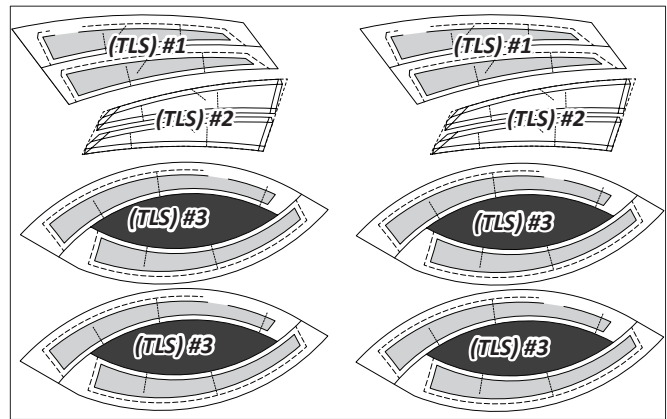
Cut out **(8)** each of Units J5 and J6 foundation papers [NP 1090] and **(2)** each of Foundation Sheets J1–J4 [NP 1091]. Place foundation papers in the assigned Bag # listed above. Cut out **(4)** each of Template Layout Sheets (TLS) #1 & #2 and **(8)** of (TLS) #3 [TP 926]. Cut out **(1)** of each template [TP 927 & 928]. Sort the templates and (TLS) in numerical order, then place them in **Template Bag J**. After the fabrics have been cut, the individual Sec. Templates from the layout sheets are placed with the associated foundation papers. Reference the newsprint graphics that follow for the location of each Unit, Template, and (TLS). *Refer to General Information for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.



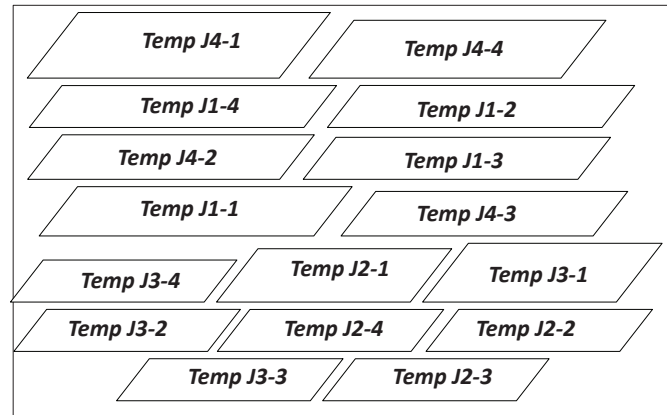

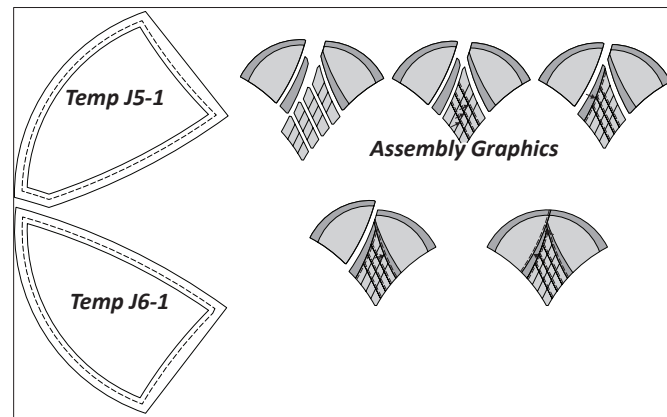

► Group J (Units J5 & J6) Fabric Chart:

The Unit Chart on the next page includes Fabric #s, yardage/ inches, and a reference as to which fabrics are paired with the Templates and Template Layout Sheets (TLS) to complete **Units J5 & J6** (a Unit Chart for the strip-pieced Units J1 to J4 comes later in the Group J instructions). The table is your guide for selecting your own colors and keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the Assigned Color column! A Color Layout at the top of the next page provides a visual reference of the location of each Fabric #.
