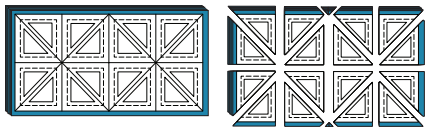


Step 2: Stack the rectangles into stacks of (12), then cut apart with the Template SS-1 Layout Sheet on top, cutting on the cut lines as you go. Clip the stacks together. Place the SS-A1 pieces into Bag SS-A and the SS-B1 stacks into Bag SS-B.

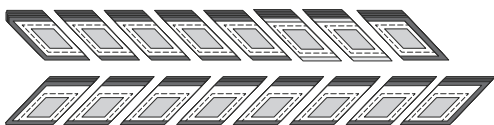
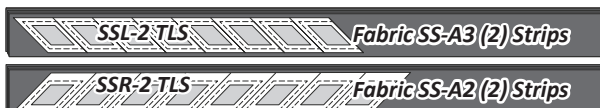
► Fabrics SS-A2, SS-A3, SS-B2, and SS-B3

Step 1: Cut the following 2-1/2" x 42" strips, then stack each set into it's own stack, with all the strips facing right-side-up.

- (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-A2
- (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-A3
- (12) 2-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-B2
- (12) 2-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-B3

Step 2: Place (1) SSR-2 TLS on the SS-A2 and SS-B2 stacks. Place (1) SSL-2 TLS on the SS-A3 and SS-B3 stacks. Cut away the excess fabric on each strip on each side of the TLS. Then, Cut on the Cut Lines to separate the pieces. Clip the TLS to the top of each stack and place the A2 and A3 stacks into Bag SS-A. Place the B2 and B3 stacks into Bag SS-B.

Steps 4, 5, & 6

► Fabrics SS-A4, SS-A5, and SS-A6

Step 1: Cut the following 4-1/2" x 42" strips, then stack each set into it's own stack, with all the strips facing right-side-up.

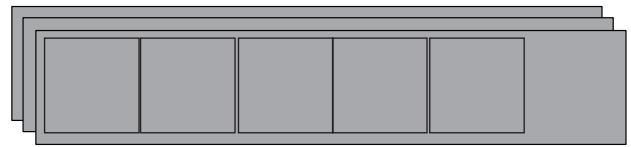
- (2) 4-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-A4
- (2) 4-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-A5
- (2) 4-1/2" x 42" strips from Fabric SS-A6

Step 2: Cut (16) 3-1/2" squares from each Fabric. Each strip yields up to (12). Clip them together by Fabric Reference (in case you've used different colors for any of them), and place them into Bag SS-A. You may want to add a label to each stack so you remember where to sew each square during final assembly.



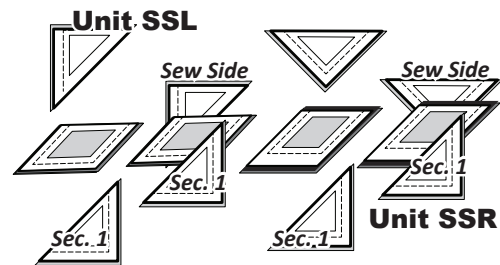
► Fabric CA6

Step 1: Cut (3) 6-3/4" x 42" strips, then stack facing right-side-up. Sub-cut (20) 6-1/2" squares from the strips. Clip these together and place in Bag CA.



STACKING BAGS SS-A AND SS-B

Work on each bag individually to avoid mixing up your fabrics. Stack the section templates and fabrics beneath for Unit SSL and SSR in each bag, as shown below.



FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING THE SMALL STAR UNITS SSL & SSR

Step 1: Place Unit SSL *right-side-up* on your table.

Step 2: Trace the dashed lines onto the back of the paper, then place a small amount of fabric glue on the backside of the paper under Sec. 1.

Step 3: Position the first piece of fabric for Sec. 1 wrong-side up on your table. Lift the Foundation Paper, slide the fabric under Sec. 1 and glue the first piece of fabric to the back. Repeat Steps 1 to 3 for each paper before moving to Step 4.

NOTE - Fabric Placement: The fabric must extend beyond the edges of the dashed lines to cover the underneath side of Sec. 1.

Step 4: Place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1, lining the edge up on the solid black line marked Line 1. Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template.

Step 5: Place the *Add-A-Quarter* ruler next to the folded back section on the paper, lip-side down, and trim the fabric with a rotary cutter.

Step 6: Remove both the *Add-A-Quarter* and the fold template. Place the fabric piece for Sec. 2, right-side up next to the folded back paper.

Step 7: Slide the fabric under Sec. 2, lining the sew-side up with the trimmed quarter-inch seam allowance. Make sure the fabric extends beyond the boundaries of the dashed lines
