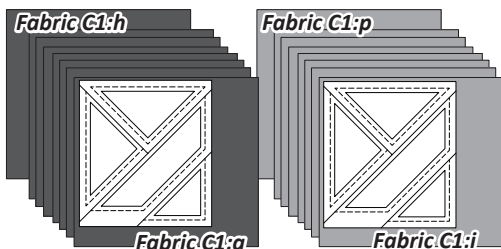


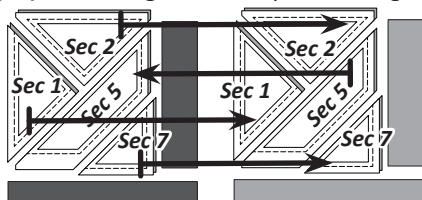


HOPSCOTCH CUTTING

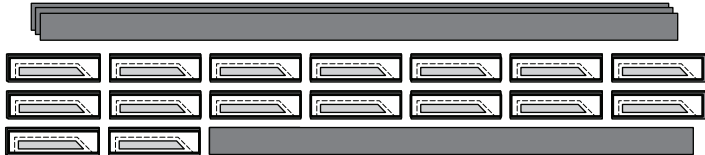
Fabrics C1:a to C1:p: Your pattern requires **(16)** 10" squares. Pair these into **(8)** contrasting pairs, **(1)** light and **(1)** dark in each pair. Place each dark fabric in **(1)** stack and the corresponding light fabric into another stack, with the paired fabrics in the same order. For organization sake, label the Fabrics C1:a to :h with :a on top, then the light stack should be C1:i to C1:p, with :i on top.



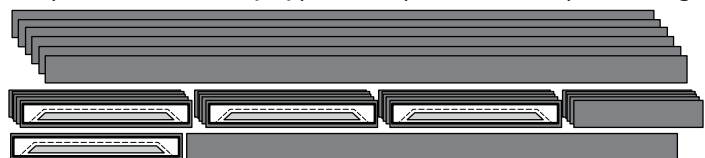
Place **(1)** **Unit CS6 TLS** on top of each stack. Cut the stack of fabrics and the TLS apart on the Cut Lines, beginning with Cut Line 1. For Sections 1, 3, and 7 place the dark fabrics on top of the light fabrics. For Section 5, place the light fabrics on top of the dark fabrics. Clip each stack of **(16)** fabrics together, and place in Bag #1.



Fabric C2: Cut **(3)** 1-1/2" strips, then stack and place **Temp CS6-2** on top and cut a total of **(16)** pieces. Clip the stack and place in Bag 1.



Fabric C3: Cut **(6)** 1-1/2" strips, then stack and place **Temp CS6-4** on top and cut a total of **(16)** pieces. Clip the stack and place in Bag 1.



Fabric C4: Cut **(3)** 1-1/2" strips, then stack and place **Temp CS6-6** on top and cut a total of **(16)** pieces. Clip the stack and place in Bag 1.



Fabric B1 (Optional): If you would like a border, we recommend a 3" finished border. Cut **(2)** 3-1/2" x 24-1/2" strips and **(2)** 3-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips from Fabric B1 (no graphic shown).
