


▼ (1) TP 925

Step 2: Position (4) Unit B1 foundation papers on each strip. The backside of each template is placed against the **wrong-side** of the fabric and secured with repositionable glue. Cut around each paper, leaving about 1/8" of excess fabric around the edges.



Step 3: Set your stitch length at your preferred basting stitch length [see more information about sewing (TRP) lines under the General Piecing Instructions on Page 5]. Sew all the (TRP) lines on each foundation paper. After the (TRP) lines are sewn, trim the threads on both the fabric side and paper side.




Step 4: Trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of template. Clip together and place in **Bag #B1**. Do not remove papers until you are ready to complete the quilt assembly.




► **Fabric B2, T-Template B-2**

Step 1: Cut (2) 10" by 42" strips from *Fabric B2*. Place strips **right-side-up** on your table in a single layer without stacking.

Step 2: Position (4) of *T-Template B-2* on each strip. The backside of each template is placed against the **right-side** of the fabric and secured with repositionable glue. Cut around each template, leaving about 1/8" of excess fabric around the edges.



Step 3: Set your stitch length at your preferred basting stitch length [see more information about sewing (TRP) lines under the General Piecing Instructions on Page 5]. Sew all the (TRP) lines on each layout sheet. After the (TRP) lines are sewn, trim the threads on both the fabric side and paper side.



Step 4: Trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of template. Clip together and place in **Bag #B1**. Do not remove papers until you are ready to complete the quilt assembly.



No further assembly is required for this group until you are ready to assemble all the Block Groups for your quilt.

► **Group B Fabric Chart:**


The Unit Chart below includes Fabric #s, yardage/inches, and a reference to which fabrics are paired with the Templates and Template Layout Sheets (TLS) to complete **Unit B1 & T-Temp B-2**. The table is your guide for selecting your own colors and keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the Assigned Color column! A Color Layout below the chart provides a visual reference of the location of each Fabric #.

► **Color Layout**

NOTE - Back-side Graphic:

The color layout displayed corresponds to the back side of your quilt and the printed side of the foundation paper. (Refer to Page 35 for a front side view of the entire quilt.)



■ **GROUP B CUTTING**

NOTE - Template Reuse: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

NOTE - Repositionable Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary.

► **Fabric B1: Unit B-1 Foundation Papers**

Step 1: Cut (2) strips measuring 8" by 42" from *Fabric B1*. Lay the strips **wrong-side-up** on your table in a single layer without stacking.
