


GROUP J CUTTING

NOTE - Template Reuse: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.


NOTE - Repositionable Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary.

► Fabric J1: (TLS) #1

Step 1: Cut (4) 8" by 42" strips from Fabric J1. Stack the strips *right-side-up* on your table. Use **Unit J1, (TLS) #1** to cut (8) pieces matching the size of the layout sheet.




Step 2: Stack the eight pieces beneath the layout sheet. Slice through the paper and fabric on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the individual sections.



Step 3: Clip the templates to the fabric, and place them with the foundation papers in **Bag #J1**.

► Fabrics J2–J6: Temp S-1


Step 1: Cut (2) 2" by 42" strips each from Fabrics J2–J6. Stack the strips, per color, *right-side-up*.



Step 2: Use **Unit J1, Temp S-1** to cut (8) pieces each from Fabrics J2–J6.



Step 3: Clip one template to each group and label with the Section # indicated for each fabric color. Place in **Bag #J1**.




► Fabric J7: (TLS) #2

Step 1: Cut (1) 9" by 42" strip from Fabric J7. Place the strip facing *right-side-up* on your table.

Step 2: Position (4) of **Unit J2, (TLS) #2** onto the strip. The backside of each layout sheet is placed against the *right-side* of the fabric and secured with repositionable glue. Cut around each layout sheet leaving about 1/8" of excess fabric around the edges.



Step 3: Set your stitch length at your preferred basting stitch length [see more information about sewing (TRP) lines under the General Piecing Instructions on Page 5]. Sew all the (TRP) lines on each layout sheet. After the (TRP) lines are sewn, trim the threads on both the fabric side and paper side.




Step 4: Trim the excess fabric around the perimeter of (TLS) #1. Then trim on *Cut Lines* in numerical order to separate **Templates J1-7**. Place the pieces into **Bag #J1**. Do not remove papers until you are ready to complete the curved paper piecing.

► Fabric J8: Template J2-1

Step 1: Cut (2) 10-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric J2. Stack the strips facing *right-side-up* on your table.

Step 2: Use **Unit J2, Template J2-1**, to cut (8) pieces, (4) from each strip, repositioning the template as needed.



Step 3: Place these pieces in **Bag #J2** with the foundation papers for Unit J2.

► Fabrics J9:a to J9:d, Template J2-2

Step 1: Cut (1) 13-1/2" by 42" strip each from Fabrics J9:a thru J9:d. Place the strips *right-side-up* on your table in a single layer without stacking.

Step 2: Position (2) of **Unit J2, Template J2-2** on each strip [see graphic at the top of the next page]. Ensure the backside of each Template is placed against the *right-side* of the fabric. Use repositionable glue and a few flower pins to secure the templates in place. Cut around each template leaving about 1/8" of excess fabric around the edges.
