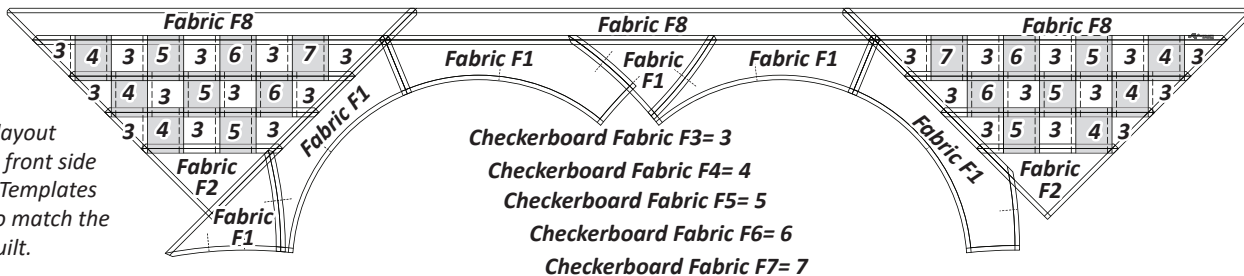


## ► Color Layout

### NOTE - Front-side

Graphic: The color layout shown matches the front side of your quilt. The T-Templates are also designed to match the front side of your quilt.



## GROUP F CUTTING

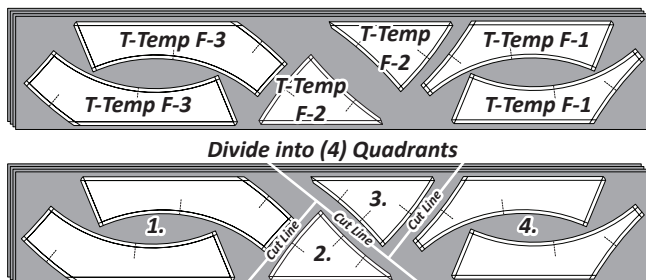
**NOTE - Template Reuse:** Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

**NOTE - Repositionable Glue:** Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary. For larger templates, it is recommended to use flower pins in combination with the glue to further secure the template and prevent shifting during sewing.

### ► Fabric F1: T-Templates F-1, F-2 & F-3

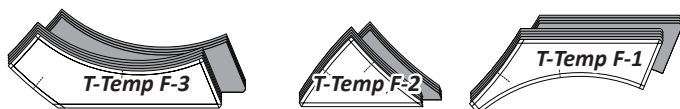
**Step 1:** Cut (4) strips measuring 7-1/2" by 42" from Fabric F1. Stack the strips *right-side-up*.

**Step 2: Cutting T-Templates F-1, F-2, and F-3:** Arrange the templates as shown in the diagram. Cut the strips into four quadrants.



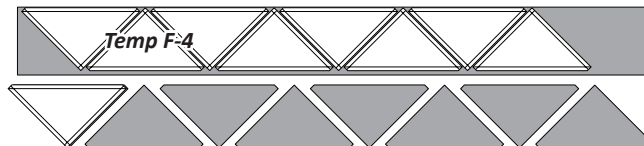
- **First Quadrant:** Use *T-Template F-3* to cut (8) pieces. (First cut (4) pieces, reposition the template, then cut another (4) pieces.)
- **Second & Third Quadrants:** Use *T-Template F-2* to cut (8) pieces. (First cut (4) pieces from the second quadrant, then reposition and cut (4) more pieces from the third quadrant.)
- **Fourth Quadrant:** Use *T-Template F-1* to cut (8) pieces. (First cut (4) pieces, reposition the template, and cut another (4) pieces.)

**Step 3:** Stack the (8) pieces beneath each template. Sew or mark the (TRP) lines to prepare them for curved piecing as outlined in the instructions. [See more information about sewing (TRP) lines under the General Piecing Instructions on Page 5.] If you choose to sew the (TRP) lines, you can sew through all (8) layers. When you are ready to begin the curved piecing, remove the threads and mark each fabric piece just before sewing the curved seams. Place these pieces in **Bag #F1**.

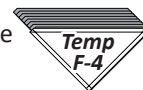


### ► Fabric F2: T-Template F-4

**Step 1:** Cut (1) 4-1/2" by 42" strip from Fabric F2. Place the strip facing *right-side-up*. Use *T-Template F-4* to cut (8) pieces.



**Step 2:** Clip the templates to the fabric, and place in **Bag #F4**.

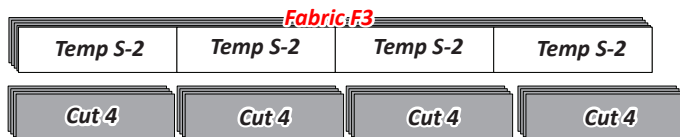
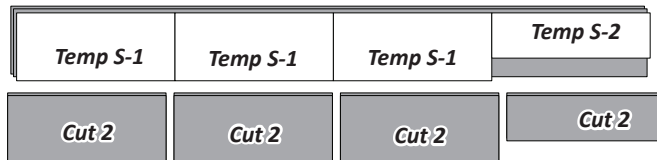


### ► Fabric F3: Templates S-1 & S-2

**NOTE - Quiltster:** If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to cut the 21" strip into the strip widths listed in Step 1.

**Step 1:** Cut (2) strips measuring 4-1/2" by 42" and (4) strips measuring 3" by 42" from Fabric F3. Stack the 4-1/2" strips together and the 3" strips together, with all strips facing *right-side-up* in two separate groups.

**Step 2:** From the 4-1/2" strips, use *Template S-1* to cut (6) pieces and *Template S-2* to cut (2) pieces. Then use *Template S-2* to cut (16) pieces from the 3" strips.



**Step 3:** Divide the S-1 pieces into (2) groups with three pieces and the S-2 pieces into (2) groups with (9) pieces. Label each stack as *Fabric F3* and place into their assigned Bag #s.
