The Unit Chart below includes Fabric #s and yardage/inches to complete the foundation piecing on Foundation Sheets S1 to S4. The table is your guide for selecting colors and keeping you organized. Don't forget to cut a fabric swatch from your chosen fabric to paste in the box in the *Assigned Color* column! A Color Layout on the previous page provides a visual reference of the location of each Fabric # in the finished unit.

## GROUP A CUTTING


**NOTE - Template Reuse:** Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces beneath each template before cutting.

**NOTE - Repositionable Glue:** Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary.

### ► Fabrics S1 to S16: Template SP

**Step 1:** Cut one 3-1/2" by 42" strip each from *Fabrics S1:a* to *Fabric S16*. Press the strips and stack facing **right-side-up** in the sewing order, starting with Fabric S16 on the bottom, moving in descending numerical order, ending with Fabric S1:a on the top.

**Step 2:** Position both **Strip Piecing Templates (SP)** as shown on top of the stack and cut (2) stacks of strips. (The leftover fabric will be used to cut swatches for the foundation papers.) Discard (1) each of Fabric S1:a and S1:b template pieces.



**NOTE - Cutting Tip:** If 16 layers of fabric is too hard to cut through, divide the strips into additional stacks. Just keep track of the strip order.

**Step 3:** Clip together the strips in each stack as shown below, placing (2) of each color together into a series of (4) groups of (8) strips each. Label groups as Rounds 1 to 4.
