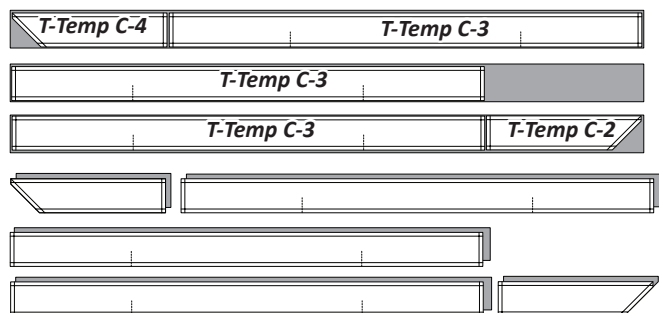


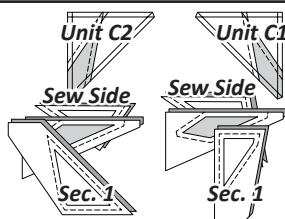
Step 2: T-Temps C-2, C-3, and C-4 are positioned on the stack as shown. Cut (12) pieces using T-Temp C-3, and cut (4) pieces using T-Temp C-2 and T-Temp C-4, matching the size of the template.



Step 3: There are TRP lines on the C-3 T-Templates. Use the Template to mark the location in the manner of your choice (erasable pin, pencil, or sew them in place with a basting stitch line so you can remove them later. Place these back into your Template Bag.

STACKING: UNIT C1 & C2 BAGS #C1 & C2

The template pieces for Units C1 and C2 are stacked in the sewing order starting with Sec. 3 on the bottom, finishing with Sec. 1 on top. The Sew Sides on Sec. 2 and 3 are aligned at the top.

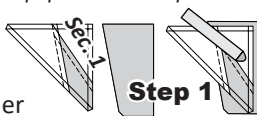


Paper piecing is only shown for Unit C1, below. You will make (16) of both Unit C1 and C2 using the same process. The units are simply mirror images of each other. Don't forget, you may have a variety of different Unit points. At this stage, it does not matter where they go in the stack, as long as you are sewing the proper fabrics to Units C1 and C2, which should have been worked out when you sorted the fabrics during the cutting process.

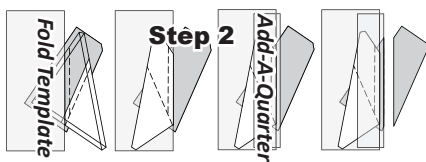
FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING: UNIT C1

NOTE - Tracing the Dashed Lines: Once you are familiar with the process for Foundation Paper Piecing, tracing the backside of the paper becomes optional.

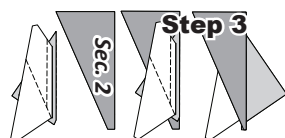
Step 1: The first piece of fabric is placed wrong-side up on your table. Lift the foundation paper, slide the fabric under Sec. 1 and glue the fabric to the backside of the paper.



Step 2: Place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1, lining the edge up with the solid black line marked Line 1. Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template. Place the Add-A-Quarter ruler next to the folded paper and trim the fabric with your rotary cutter.

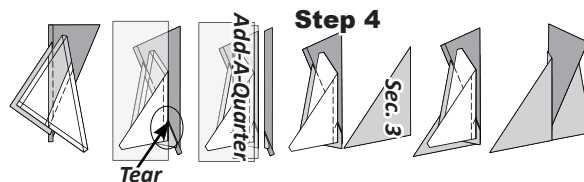


Step 3: Place the fabric piece for Sec. 2, right-side up next to the folded back paper. Lift the paper, and slide the fabric under Sec. 1, lining the sew-side up with the trimmed seam



allowance, then open the paper and sew on Line 1. Flip over and press the Sec. 2 fabric open on the backside of each paper.

Step 4: Repeat this process to add Section 3. Note that you will have to tear back the paper slightly during the folding process, before you trim your line.



Step 5: Trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of each foundation unit. Don't remove the foundation papers at this time. Place these pieces in Bag #C1.

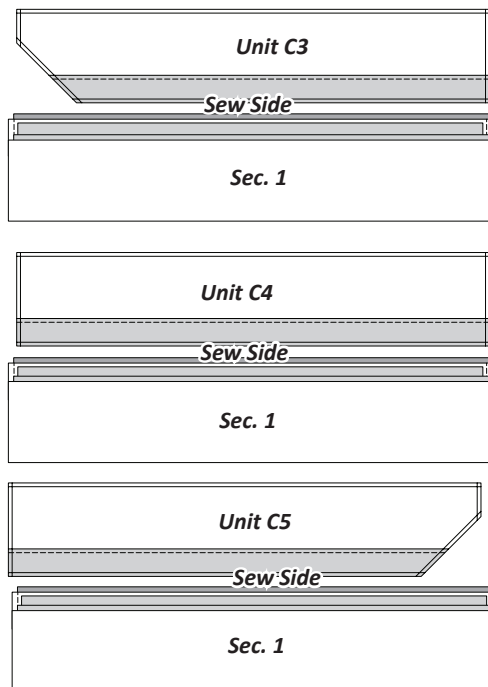


Step 6: Repeat these steps with Unit C2 and place the finished pieces back into Bag #C2. The only difference is that this unit is a Mirror image, and Sec. 1 is on the opposite side of the unit to help create a locking seam where the star points come together. Don't remove the foundation papers at this time.



STACKING: UNITS C3 TO C5, BAG #C3

The template pieces for Units C3 to C5 are stacked in the sewing order starting with Sec. 2 on the bottom, finishing with Sec. 1 on top. The Sew Side on Sec. 2 is aligned at the top.



PAPER PIECING: UNITS C3

NOTE - Tracing the Dashed Lines: Optional.

Step 1: The first piece of fabric is placed wrong-side up on your table. Lift the foundation paper, slide the fabric under Sec. 1 and glue the fabric to the backside of the paper.
