

► Fabric C15: Templates C11-2, C12-1, C13-2, C14-1, C15-2 & C16-1

Step 1: Cut (4) 12" by 42" strips from Fabric C15. Stack the strips right-side-up. Apply a small amount of repositionable glue to the back of each Unit Template for C11-2, C12-1, C13-2, C14-1, C15-2 & C16-1. Place these templates onto the right side of the fabric and cut (4) pieces per template.



Step 2: Pair the templates with the foundation papers found in Bag #C3.




► Fabric C16: Templates C11-1, C12-2, C13-1, C14-2, C15-1 & C16-2

NOTE - Quiltster App: If you precut your strips according to Quiltster, you will need to subcut each 7" strip into (2) 3-1/2"-wide strips to total the number of strips in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (8) 3-1/2" by 42" strips from *Fabric C16*. Stack the strips right-side-up into two stacks of (4) strips each.

Step 2: Apply a small amount of repositionable glue to the back of each Unit Template for C11-2, C12-1, C13-2, C14-1, C15-2, & C16-1. Place these templates onto the rightside of the fabric and cut (4) pieces per template.





Step 3: Pair the templates with the foundation papers found in Bag #C3.




STACKING: UNITS C11-C16, BAG #C3

FOUNDATION PIECING: UNITS C11-C16



to adhere the fabric to the backside of the paper. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 for each foundation paper.

Step 3: Place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1, lining the edge up with the solid black line marked Line 1.

Step 4: Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template.



Step 7: Lift the paper and slide the fabric under Sec. 2, lining the sew-side up with the trimmed seam allowance. Repeat Steps 3-6 for each foundation paper before moving on to Step 8. Fabric Under Sec.
