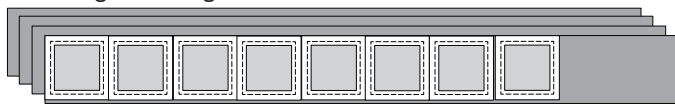


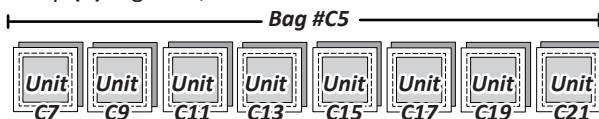
► Fabric C14, Temp S-2

Step 1: Cut and stack (4) 4-1/2" x 42" strips from *Fabric C14* and position the fabric facing *right-side up*.

Step 2: *Temp S-2* is used to cut (8) pieces matching the size and shape of the Template from each strip for a total of (32) pieces. These all go into Bag #C5:



- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C7.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C9.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C11.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C13.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C15.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C17.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C19.
- Clip (4) together, and label as Unit C21.

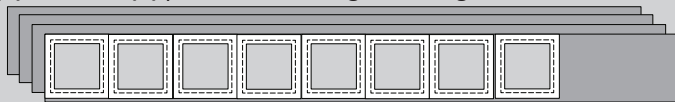


► Fabrics C14 to C20, Temp S-2, Colorways 2 and 3

NOTE - Colorway #2 & #3: Use these instructions only for Colorway 2 or 3.

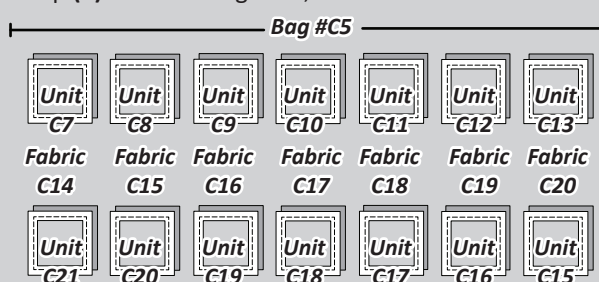
Step 1: Cut and stack (1) 4-1/2" x 42" strip from *Fabric C14* to *C20*. Position the fabric facing *right-side up*.

Step 2: *Temp S-2* is used to cut (8) pieces matching the size and shape of the Template from each strip. Sort these by color, into (2) stacks of (4) pieces. These all go into Bag #C5.



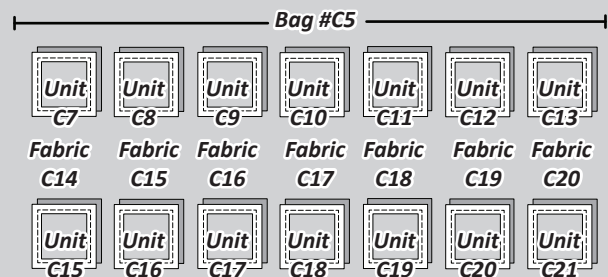
Step 3: Sorting for Colorway 2 is as follows:

- Clip (4) Fabric 14 together, and label as Unit C7.
- Clip (4) Fabric 15 together, and label as Unit C8.
- Clip (4) Fabric 16 together, and label as Unit C9.
- Clip (4) Fabric 17 together, and label as Unit C10.
- Clip (4) Fabric 18 together, and label as Unit C11.
- Clip (4) Fabric 19 together, and label as Unit C12.
- Clip (4) Fabric 20 together, and label as Unit C13.
- Clip (4) Fabric 20 together, and label as Unit C15.
- Clip (4) Fabric 19 together, and label as Unit C16.
- Clip (4) Fabric 18 together, and label as Unit C17.
- Clip (4) Fabric 17 together, and label as Unit C18.
- Clip (4) Fabric 16 together, and label as Unit C19.
- Clip (4) Fabric 15 together, and label as Unit C20.
- Clip (4) Fabric 14 together, and label as Unit C21.



Step 4: Sorting for Colorway 3 is as follows:

- Clip (4) Fabric 14 together, and label as Unit C7.
- Clip (4) Fabric 15 together, and label as Unit C8.
- Clip (4) Fabric 16 together, and label as Unit C9.
- Clip (4) Fabric 17 together, and label as Unit C10.
- Clip (4) Fabric 18 together, and label as Unit C11.
- Clip (4) Fabric 19 together, and label as Unit C12.
- Clip (4) Fabric 20 together, and label as Unit C13.
- Clip (4) Fabric 14 together, and label as Unit C15.
- Clip (4) Fabric 15 together, and label as Unit C16.
- Clip (4) Fabric 16 together, and label as Unit C17.
- Clip (4) Fabric 17 together, and label as Unit C18.
- Clip (4) Fabric 18 together, and label as Unit C19.
- Clip (4) Fabric 19 together, and label as Unit C20.
- Clip (4) Fabric 20 together, and label as Unit C21.



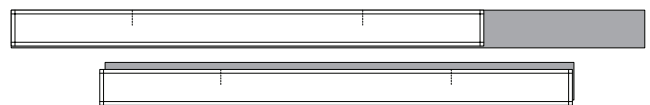
► Fabric C21: T-Temp C-1

NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 7-1/2" strip into (3) 2-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (12) 2-1/2" by 42" strips from *Fabric C21*. Stack the strips facing *right-side up*.



Step 2: *T-Temp C-1* is positioned on the stack as shown. Cut (12) pieces using *T-Temp C-1*, matching the size of the template.



Step 3: There are TRP lines on these Templates. Use the Template to mark the location in the manner of your choice: using an erasable pin or pencil, or by sewing on the line with a basting stitch, which can be removed later. Place these back into your Template Bag.

► Fabric C22: T-Temp C-2, C-3, & C-4

NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 7-1/2" strip into (3) 2-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (12) 2-1/2" by 42" strips from *Fabric C22*. Stack the strips facing *right-side up*.
