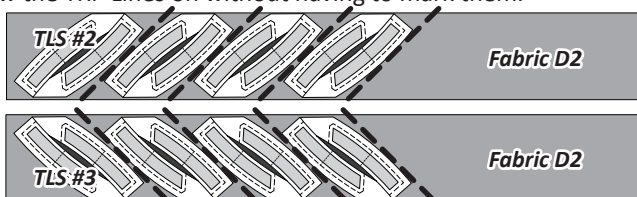


## ► Fabric D2, TLS #2 & #3

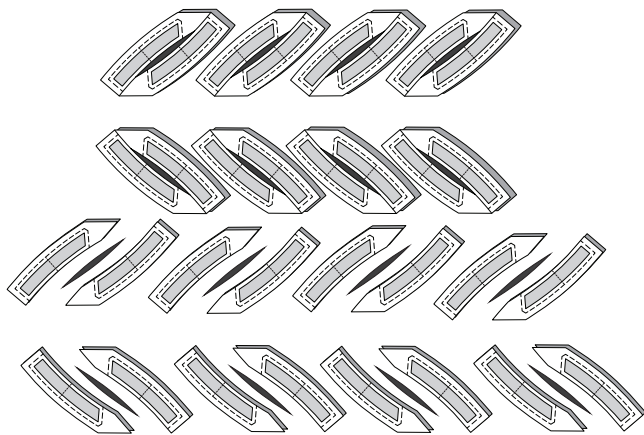
**NOTE - Quiltster APP:** If you have used Quiltster, you were told to cut (1) 11-1/2" strip. Subcut this to (2) 5-3/4" strips.

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 5-3/4" by 42" strips from *Fabric D2*. Place the strips facing **right-side-up**. Using repositionable glue on the back of the paper, **position TLS #2 & #3 on the strips as shown**. Rough cut (4) pieces by cutting a straight line between each TLS. Note that we have given you a Template for each Unit so that you can sew the TRP Lines without having to mark them.



**Step 2:** Take each piece to the sewing machine at this time to add your TRP Lines, using a basting stitch of your preferred size.

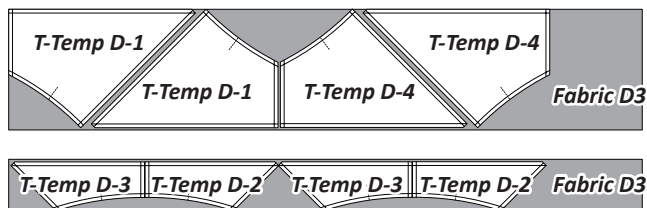
**Step 3:** Finish the cutting by trimming on the outside solid line of each TLS, then on Cut lines 1 and 2 to cut these apart. Stack the like pieces and clip (1) Template to the top of each stack. Place these stacks into Bag #D1.



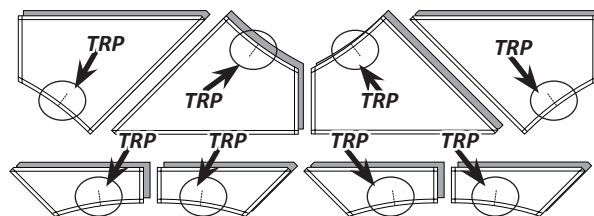
## ► Fabric D3, T-Temp D-1 to D-4

**NOTE - Quiltster APP:** If you have used Quiltster, you were told to cut (2) 11-1/2" strips, which each need to be cut into (1) 8" and (1) 3-1/2" strip.

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 8" and (2) 3-1/2" strips from *Fabric D3*. Stack the strips of like size, facing **right-side-up**. Position **T-Temp D-1 to D-4** on the strips as shown below. Cut (4) pieces the size and shape of each (T-Temp), repositioning them as necessary. We did not provide (4) pieces of each of these, so you will need to mark your TRP lines using your preferred TRP line method. If you aren't sure, reference Pg. 5 for options and choose the one you like the best.



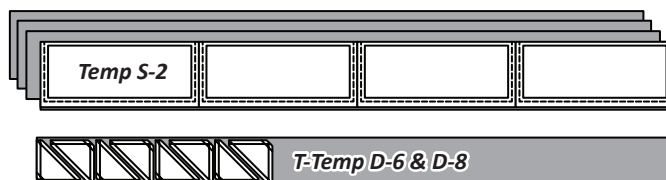
**Step 2:** Cut around the T-Template stacks, then take the pieces to your machine and sew the TRP Lines using your preferred method and basting stitch size. Clip the paper templates to the fabric beneath. Place the templates in Bag #D3.



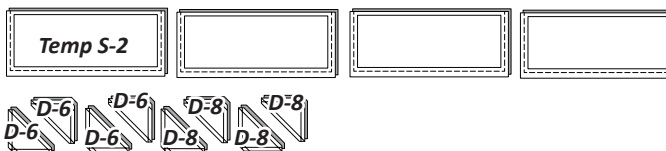
## ► Fabric D4, Temp S-2, T-Temps D-6 & D-8

**NOTE - Quiltster APP:** If you have used the Quiltster APP, then you have cut (1) 21-1/4" Strip. Subcut this strip into (4) 4-1/2" strips and (1) 3-1/4" strip.

**Step 1:** Cut and stack (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips and (1) 3-1/4" by 42" strips from *Fabric D4* facing **right-side-up**. Position **Temp S-2** onto the (4) 4-1/2" strips and **T-Temp D-6 and D-8** onto the 3-1/4" strip.



**Step 2:** Cut (16) pieces the size and shape of the **Temp S-2**, repositioning it as necessary. Repositionable glue will keep the templates from moving during the cutting process. Cut (4) pieces the size of **T-Temp D-6** and (4) **T-Temp D-8**.

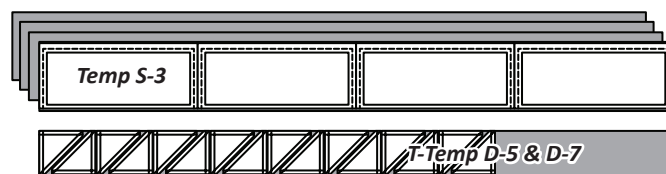


**Step 3:** Clip the like templates together placing the **Temp S-2** pieces into Bag #D2 and the **T-Temp D-6 and D-8** into Bag #D3.

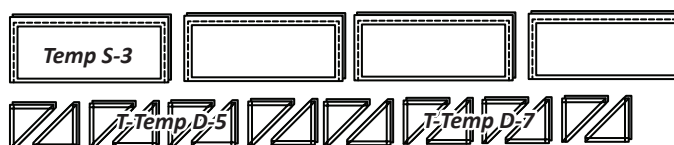
## ► Fabric D5, Temp S-3, T-Temps D-5 & D-7

**NOTE - Quiltster APP:** If you have used the Quiltster APP, then you have cut (1) 21-1/4" Strip. Subcut this strip into (4) 4-1/2" strips and (1) 3-1/4" strip.

**Step 1:** Cut and stack (4) 4-1/2" by 42" strips and (1) 3-1/4" by 42" strips from *Fabric D5* facing **right-side-up**. Position **Temp S-3** onto the (4) 4-1/2" strips and **T-Temp D-5 and D-7** onto the 3-1/4" strip.



**Step 2:** Cut (16) pieces the size and shape of the **Temp S-3**, repositioning it as necessary. Repositionable glue will keep the templates from moving during the cutting process. Cut (8) pieces the size of **T-Temp D-5** and (8) **T-Temp D-7**.



**Step 3:** Clip the like templates together placing the **Temp S-3** pieces into Bag #D2 and the **T-Temp D-5 and D-7** into Bag #D3.
