

RAINBOW CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

The first thing you will notice about this pattern is that it requires a lot of rainbow fabrics! These fabrics are not hard to keep straight as long as they are organized from the start. This section will help you do that. Once you have organized and labeled your fabrics, you will either place them in the proper bag for cutting later in the pattern, or complete some cutting in this section, and place your cut pieces in their appropriate bags, ready for piecing.

If you have purchased a kit in the coversheet colorway, you will see that it has been organized for you and labeled as follows:

- Red Fabrics are labeled as "R"
- Orange Fabrics are labeled as "O"
- Yellow fabrics are labeled as "Y"
- Green fabrics are labeled as "G"
- Teal fabrics are labeled as "T"
- Blue fabrics are labeled as "B"
- Purple fabrics are labeled as "PL"
- Pink fabrics are labeled as "PK"

There are (8) fabrics required from each of the (8) colors of the rainbow to complete quilt on the cover. A table outlining each fabric, how much yardage you need and a swatch box to track your fabrics is shown below. If you want to use a different collection, this will be your key for keeping new fabrics organized. There is also a picture on Page 39 that tells you where each fabric goes.


NOTE - Template Cut Sizes: The templates used in the following instructions for the Rainbow cutting will have cut sizes on them. These cut sizes were established if the pieces are all cut out of the same fabric. Since we are sharing strips for different units across different groups, which is common in a rainbow quilt, ignore the cut sizes on these templates and instead, follow the instructions included herein. This only applies to the Rainbow Cutting section; follow printed cut sizes elsewhere.

► Fabric R1 to PK1

Step 1: Cut (1) 9" strip from each Fabric R1 to PK1. Stack them right-side up, in the order, R1 on top, then O1, Y1, G1, T1, B1, PL1, and PK1 on the bottom, on the cutting table. This fabric will be used with:

- (8) T-Template B-2 [TP 925, Group B]
- Temp AC3-1 [TP 913, Group A]
- (8) TLS #3 from your Group J blocks, Temp J6-2 and J5-2 [TP 926, Group J].

Step 2: Before you can complete the cutting, you will need to cut apart your Temp AC3-1 Template. Cut this apart on Cut Line 1.
