


Step 5: You will repeat the same process for *T-Template J-1*. Place the piece on the untrimmed fabrics, one at a time. Sew the TRPs in place, then trim around the outside solid line. Next, trim away the excess fabrics. Clip together and place into Bag #J1.

► **Fabric R6 to PK6**


Step 1: Cut (1) 11" strip from each Fabric R6 to PK6. We suggest immediately cutting this into an 11" x 21" rectangle at this point. You can save the other half for another project (*Note, if you have purchased a kit, you likely have 13-1/2", so if you want, you can just leave it at that width for a little extra wiggle room, see below*). Stack them right-side up, in the order, R6 on top, then O6, Y6, G6, T6, B6, PL6, and PK6 on the bottom, on the cutting table. This fabric will be used with:

- Unit J6, Temp J6-1 [TP 928, Group J]
- Unit J5, Temp J5-1 [TP 928, Group J]
- Unit AC1, TLS #4, [TP 913, Group A].






Step 2: Place the cutting templates on your stack of fabrics. Cut around each one on the outside solid line. Cut **TLS #4** apart, then place between Temps J6-1 and J5-1. Clip the **Unit AC1, TLS #4** pieces together and place into Bag #AC1.

Sub-cut (8) 13-1/2" by 21" Rectangles



Sub-cut (8) 11" by 21" Rectangles



Step 3: Clip the Temp J6-1 together and place in Bag #J3. Clip the J5-1 pieces together and place in Bag #J2.
