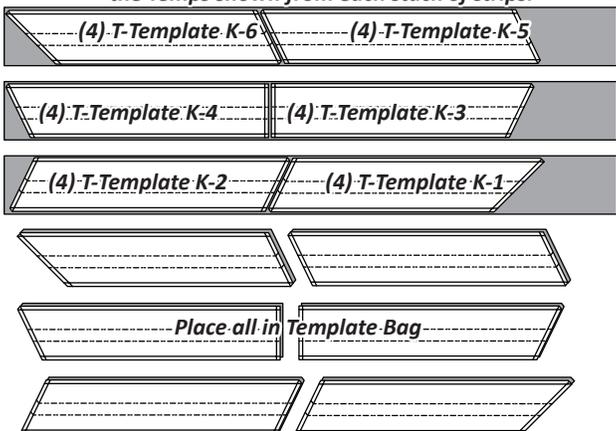


quilt, you will always cut (4) pieces for each T-Template. Clip the pieces together and place into the Template Bag.

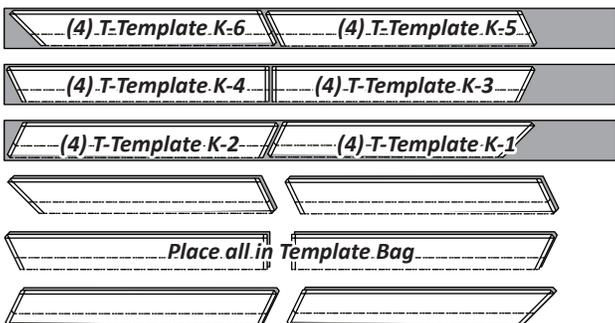
► **4" Strip Cutting 96" to 118" Quilt**

Cut (12) 4" Strips and stack into (3) stacks of (4). Cut the Temps shown from each stack of strips.



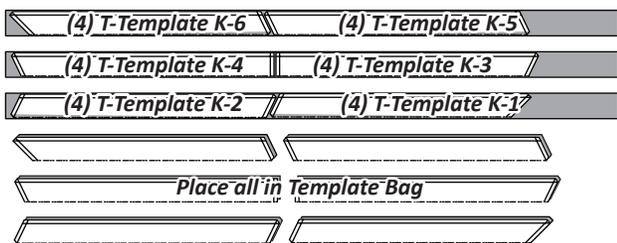
► **2-3/4" Strip Cutting 99" to 118" Quilt**

Cut (12) 2-3/4" Strips and stack into (3) stacks of (4). Cut the Temps shown from each stack of strips.



► **1-3/4" Strip Cutting 100" to 118" Quilt**

Cut (12) 1-3/4" Strips and stack into (3) stacks of (4). Cut the Temps shown from each stack of strips.



► **Fabric K2: (TLS) #4, #5, & Temp. S-3**

*NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, each 26-1/4" strip is subcut into (1) 1-3/4" strip (2) 5-1/4" strips, and (2) 7" strips to achieve the cutting instructions below.*

**Step 1:** Cut (4) 1-3/4" by 42" strips, then cut (8) 5-1/4" by 42" strips and then (8) 7" by 42" strips from Fabric K2. Stack the strips of equal size facing **right-side up** into three separate stacks.

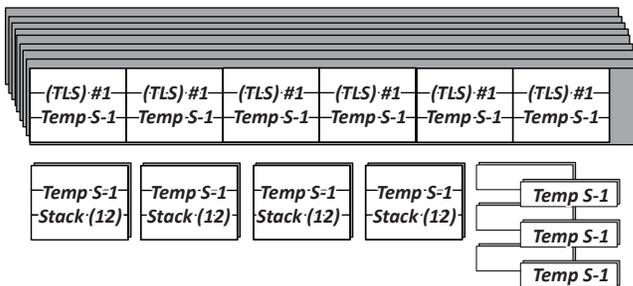
**Step 2:** Unit K1 & K38 (Temp S-3) is used to cut (16) pieces from the 1<sup>st</sup> stack measuring 1-3/4" by 42". Place these pieces in Bag #K1. Eight pieces are placed with each Unit K1 and K38.



**Step 3:** Units K2 thru K37 (Temp S-1 Layout Sheet #1) is used to cut (48) pieces matching the size of the (TLS #1) from the 2<sup>nd</sup> stack measuring 5-1/4" by 42".

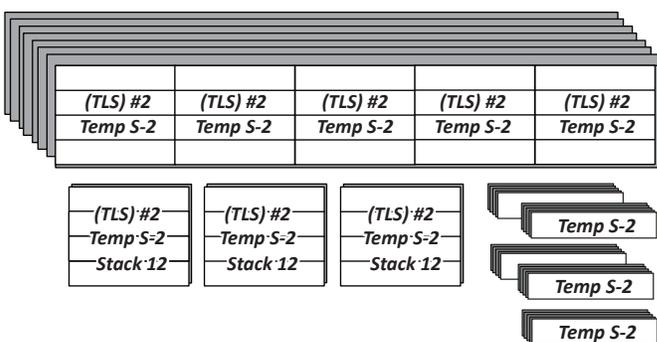
**Step 4:** Position (12) pieces beneath each (TLS) and complete the cutting on each Cut Line 1-3. Place these pieces in the bags as follows:

- Bag #K1: (16) pieces
- Bag #K2: (24) pieces
- Bag #K3: (24) pieces
- Bag #K4: (16) pieces
- Bag #K5: (16) pieces
- Bag #K6: (16) pieces
- Bag #K7: (16) pieces
- Bag #K8: (16) pieces



**Step 5:** Units K2 thru K37 (Temp S-2 Layout Sheet #2) is used to cut (40) pieces matching the size of the (TLS) from the 3<sup>rd</sup> stack measuring 7" by 42". Position (12) pieces beneath the (3) (TLS). Complete the cutting on each Cut Line 1-3. Place these pieces in the bags as listed below.

- Bag #K1: (16) pieces
- Bag #K2: (24) pieces
- Bag #K3: (24) pieces
- Bag #K4: (16) pieces
- Bag #K5: (16) pieces
- Bag #K6: (16) pieces
- Bag #K7: (16) pieces
- Bag #K8: (16) pieces

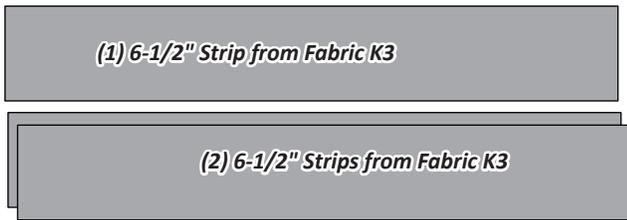


► **Fabric K3: T-Temp K-2, Temp K-3, TLS #3**

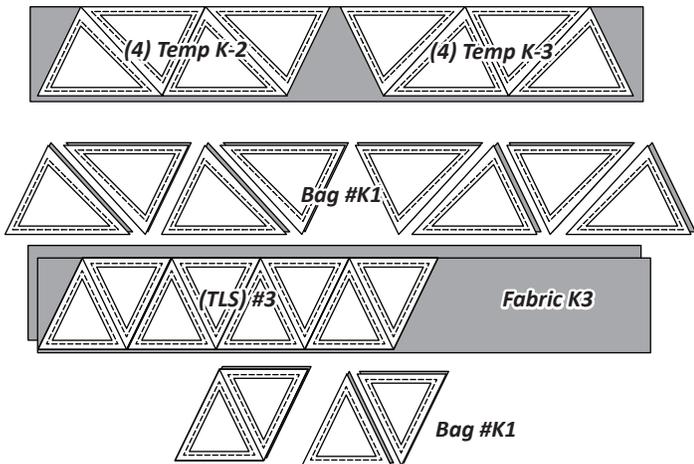
*NOTE - If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut the 19-1/2" strip into (3) 6-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.*

**Step 1:** Cut (3) 6-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric K3. The strips are stacked facing right-side up into (2) groups, one with (1) strip and one with (2) strips. (See Graphic at top of next page)

**Step 2:** Place Temps K-2 and K-3 onto the (1) strip stack, and cut (4) pieces the size of each Temp. Clip the K-2 pieces together, then



put them with (4) Unit K1 in Bag #K1. Clip the K-3 pieces together and put them with (4) Unit K38, in Bag #K1. Use **TLS #3** on the stack of (2) strips. Cut (8) pieces the size of the TLS, then stack these, cut the stack apart on Cut Line 1, clip them together, and place into Bag #K1 to be used with Units K9, K17, K22, and K30.



► **Fabric K4: TLS #3**

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 6-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric K4. The strips are stacked facing right-side up.

**Step 2:** Place **TLS #3** onto the strip stack, and cut (12) pieces the size of the TLS.



**Step 3:** Stack the pieces into (1) stack, place TLS on top of it, then cut it apart on the cut line. Clip the stacks together and place them in Bag #K2. You will use this fabric with all of the Units in this bag.

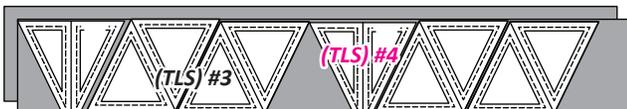


► **Fabric K5: TLS #3 and #4**

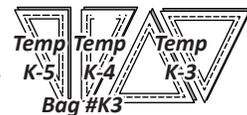
**NOTE - TLS #4 Correction:** On the first printing, TLS #4 was printed with (2) Template K-4. Relabel the template so the one on the left says Temp K-5, which is used with Unit K20.

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 6-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric K5. The strips are stacked facing right-side up.

**Step 2:** Place **TLS #3** and #4 onto the strip stack, and cut (8) pieces the size of **TLS #3** and (4) pieces the size of **TLS #4**.



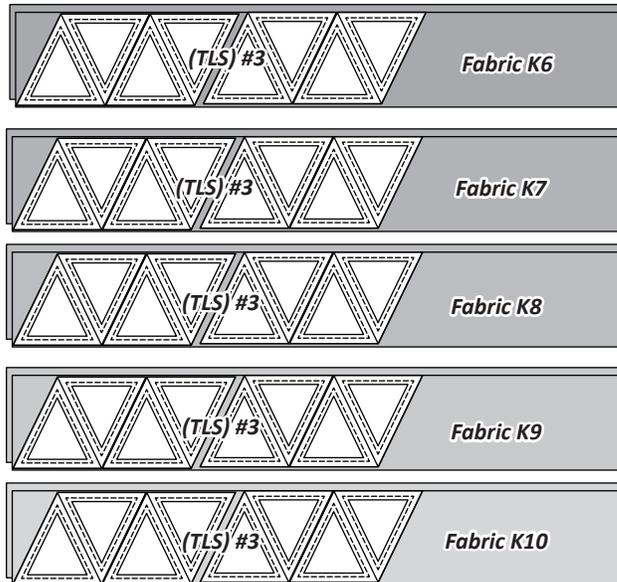
**Step 3:** Stack the pieces into (1) stack for each size, then place the corresponding TLS on top. Cut each stack apart on the cut line. Clip the stacks together and place them in Bag #K3. **Temp K-4** should be clipped to Unit K19, **Temp K-5** should be clipped to Unit K20. The **Temp K-1** pieces are used for all of the remaining Units, K3, K11, K28, and K36.



► **Fabric K6 to K10: TLS #3**

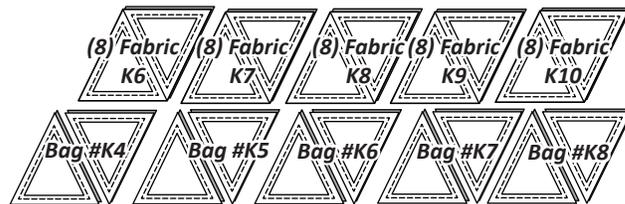
**Step 1:** Cut (2) 6-1/2" by 42" strips from each Fabric K6 to K10. The strips are stacked facing right-side up, by color.

**Step 2:** Place (1) **TLS #3** onto the each strip stack, and cut (8) pieces the size of the TLS. Reposition it for each cut.



**Step 3:** Stack the pieces into (1) stack, place **TLS #3** on top of it, then cut it apart on the cut line. Clip the stacks together and place them into bags as follows. You will use the same fabric with all of the Units in each of the bags.

- Bag K4: Fabric K6, Units K4, K12, K27, K35
- Bag K5: Fabric K7, Units K5, K13, K26, K34
- Bag K6: Fabric K8, Units K6, K14, K25, K33
- Bag K7: Fabric K9, Units K7, K15, K24, K32
- Bag K8: Fabric K10, Units K8, K16, K23, K31



**FABRIC K11: T-TEMPS K-7 TO K-12**

**NOTE - Quiltster APP:** If you pre-cut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut your total yardage into further strips. Stack your 10" strips into (1) stack of (4), then cut (4) sets of (4) 2-1/2" strips.
