

Don't forget to cut a swatch of your chosen fabric to paste in the box under the Assigned Color column! If you decide to use more than one fabric for one or more of the colors, divide the inches yardage in half, and place two swatches next to the table. Label one swatch :a and one :b. Make sure that all the :a fabrics go in the same blocks and all the :b fabrics go in the same block.

NOTE - Template Reuse: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the required number of cuts outlined in the Cutting Instructions. Carefully read the instructions to ensure the correct number of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

NOTE - Repositionable Glue: Before cutting your fabrics, apply repositionable glue to the backside of each template to prevent the TLS from shifting during cutting. This allows you to remove and reposition the template as needed. For larger templates, it is recommended to use flower pins in combination with the glue to further secure the template and prevent shifting during sewing.


NOTE - Fabric Glue: Use fabric glue to secure smart corners and raw edges when aligning two fabric pieces before sewing a seam.

CUTTING FABRICS:

NOTE - Using more than one Fabric?: Cut (2) 3" strips from Fabrics AT1:a and (2) from AT1:b. Stack these so the AT1:a fabrics are all on top of the AT1:b fabrics before piecing.

► Fabric AT1: (TLS) #1

Step 1: Cut (4) 3" by 42" strips from Fabric AT1 and stack facing **right-side up**. Use **Unit AT1, (TLS #1)** to cut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of the (TLS).



Step 2: Cut on Line 1 to separate the individual section templates. Place these pieces in Bag #AT1.




► Fabric AT2: (T-TLS) #2 thru #9

NOTE - Quiltster App: If you precut your strips using the Quiltster App, you will need to sub-cut each 6-1/2" strip into (1) 2-1/2" strip and (2) 2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

NOTE - Using more than one Fabric?: Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips and (4) 2" strips from each Fabric AT2:a and AT2:b. Stack these into (3) stacks with (2) AT2:a fabrics on top of (2) AT2:b fabrics for cutting, then restack each stack with all of the :a fabrics on top of all of the :b fabrics before piecing.

Step 1: Cut (4) 2-1/2" by 42" strips and (8) 2" by 42" strips from Fabric AT2. Stack the strips **right-side up** on your table into three groups of (4) strips.

Step 2: **Unit AT1, (TLS #2)** and **Unit AT2, (TLS #3)** are placed with the first (4) 2-1/2" strips. Subcut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of each layout sheet.



Step 3: Cut on Line 1 to separate the individual section templates, then place the templates and (8) fabric pieces in their assigned Bag #s.




Step 4: **Unit AT1, (TLS #4)** and **Unit AT2, (TLS #5)** are placed with the first (4) 2" strips. Subcut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of each layout sheet.



Step 5: Cut on Line 1 to separate the individual section templates, then place the templates and (8) fabric pieces in their assigned Bag #s.



Step 6: **Unit AT1, (TLS #6 & #8)** and **Unit AT2, (TLS #7 & #9)** are placed with the last (4) 2" strips. Subcut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of each layout sheet.



Step 7: Cut on Line 1 to separate the individual section templates, then place the templates and (8) fabric pieces in their assigned Bag #s.




► Fabric AT3: (T-TLS) #10 & 11

NOTE - Using more than one Fabric?: Cut (2) 4" strips from Fabrics AT3:a and (2) from AT3:b. Stack these so the AT3:a fabrics are all on top of the AT3:b fabrics before piecing.

Step 1: Cut (4) 4" by 42" strips from Fabric AT3. Stack the strips **right-side up**. **Units AT1 & Unit AT2, (TLS #s 10 & 11)** are used to subcut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of each layout sheet.



Step 2: Each layout sheet yields (8) pieces for sections AT-2, AT-5, AT-8, & AT-11, for Units AT1 & AT2. Complete the cutting on each Cut Line in numerical order, then place in their assigned Bag #.



► Fabric AT4: (TLS) #12 & #13

NOTE - Using more than one Fabric?: Cut (2) 6" strips from Fabrics AT4:a and (2) from AT4:b. Stack these so the AT4:a fabrics are all on top of the AT4:b fabrics before piecing.

Step 1: Cut (4) 6" by 42" strips from Fabric AT4. Stack the strips **right-side up**. **Units AT1 & Unit AT2, (TLS #s 12 & 13)** are used to subcut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of each layout sheet.
