

**Step 2:** Each layout sheet yields (8) pieces for sections AT-3, AT-6, AT-9, & AT-12, for Units AT1 & AT2. Complete the cutting on each Cut Line in numerical order, then place in their assigned Bag #.

► **Fabric AT5: (TLS) #14 & #15**

**NOTE - Using more than one Fabric?:** Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip from Fabrics AT5:a and (1) from AT5:b. Stack these so the AT5:a fabrics are all on top of the AT5:b fabrics before piecing.

**Step 1:** Cut (2) 2-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric AT5. Stack the strips **right-side up**. Units AT1 & Unit AT2, (TLS #s 14 & 15) are used to subcut (4) fabric pieces matching the size of each layout sheet.




**Step 2:** Stack (4) fabric pieces beneath each layout sheet. Cut on Line 1 to complete the cutting. Place the (8) pieces for section AT1-13 in Bag AT-1, and the (8) pieces for section AT2-13 in Bag AT-2.



**SORTING AND STACKING: UNITS AT1**

Position the templates and fabric pieces for Units AT1 in numerical order facing **right-side up**, with the **sew-sides** aligned at the top. Sec. 1 does not have a sew side.






**Stacking:** The stacking begins with the largest Sec. # on the bottom. You should have (8) fabric pieces for each section. Continue stacking in reverse order, ending with Sec. 1 on top. If you are using more than one color for any of these sections, make sure you have (4) :a fabrics on the top and (4) :b fabrics on the bottom.

The stacking process for Unit AT2 is identical, except the pieces are **mirror images**. Since the only difference is the reversed orientation, additional graphics are not provided.

**Numbering and Labeling Papers:** For more than one colorway, number your papers #1 to #8 and put a little swatch of fabrics on them to remind yourself to check your fabrics! Each time you add a new section, put your papers back in order and you will always add the :a fabrics to the first (4) papers and :b fabrics to the last (4) papers.

**FOUNDATION PIECING: UNIT AT1**

**NOTE - Tracing the Dashed Lines:** Place the foundation paper onto a light table printed side down. Trace the dashed lines printed on the front side of the paper, onto the backside of the paper.



**NOTE - Trimming the Threads:** Sewing 4 to 5 stitches past the ends of your sew lines makes it possible to cut the thread ends off each time you trim with your Add-A-Quarter ruler.

**Step 8:** Loosen the glue under Sec. 1, then press the fabric pieces open on the backside of each paper.

**Step 9:** a) Position the fold template over the top of Sections 1 and 2, lining the edge
