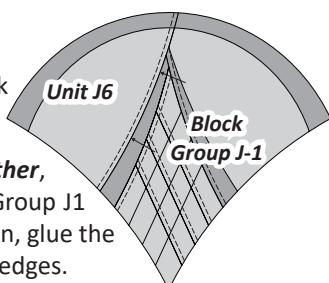


Step 6: Sew, then press the seam toward Unit J5.

► **Assembly Graphic 5**

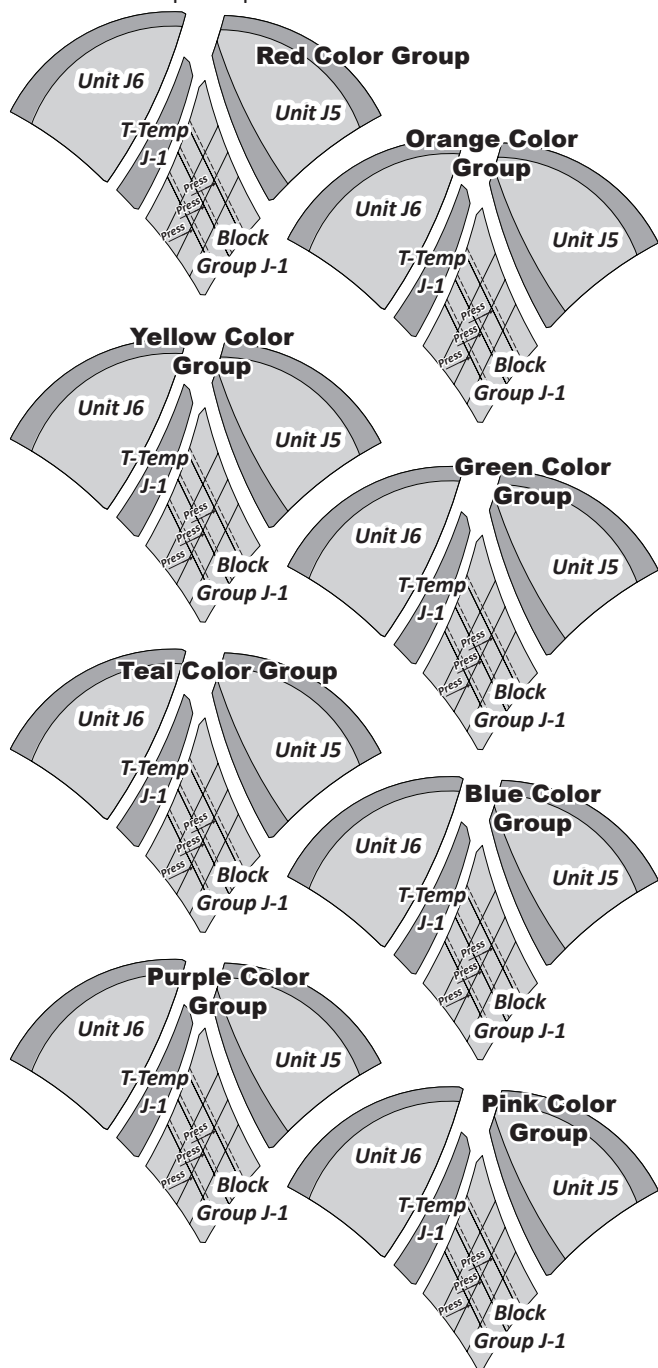
Step 7: Join Unit J6 with Block Group J1.



Step 8: With *right-sides-together*, Unit J5 is placed on the bottom, Group J1 on top. Align the (TRP) lines and pin, glue the smart corners and secure the raw edges.

Step 9: Sew and press the seam toward Unit J6.

To avoid Y seams in the assembly process, the remaining blocks are **NOT** joined at this time. Set aside the pieces until you are ready to assemble the quilt top.



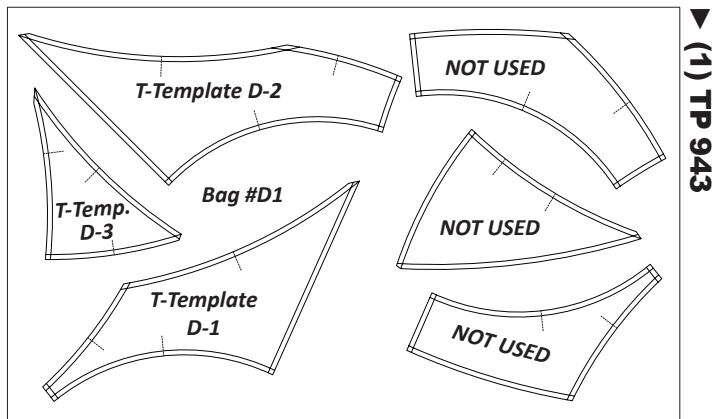
GROUP D: BLANK D BORDER INSTRUCTIONS

Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (1) large bag to complete the organization for these instructions. Label the bags as follows.

- Bag #D1: (1) each of T-Templates D-1 thru D-3

► **Preparing Templates:**

Cut out (1) each of T-Temps D-1, D-2 & D-3 [TP 943] and place in Bag #B1; note that T-Temps G-1, G-2, & G-3 on TP 943 are not used in this layout, so you don't need to cut them out. Reference the newsprint graphics that follow for the location of each Template. *Refer to General Information for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your templates.



► **Group D Fabric Chart:**

The Unit Chart below includes Fabric #s, yardage/inches, and a reference to which fabrics are paired with the Templates to complete *T-Temps D-1 thru D-3*. A Color Layout in the next column provides a visual reference of the location of Fabric D1 in the quilt.

GROUP D CUTTING

NOTE - Template Reuse: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

NOTE - Repositionable Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary.

► **Fabric D1, Temps D-1 thru D-3**

NOTE - Using the Quiltster APP: If you precut your fabric using the Quiltster app, you will need to sub-cut *each* 18" strip into (2) 9" strips to achieve the total strip widths listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (8) strips measuring 9" by 42" from Fabric D1. Stack the strips *wrong-side-up* on your table.
